1 - GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1 Product Description for Equipment Under Test (EUT)

The *Firefly Lighting Co., Ltd.*.'s model *XEU48-18U* or the "EUT" as referred to in this report is a *Energy -Saving Lamp* which measures approximately in the table, rated input voltage: AC 120 V/60Hz.

The test data was only good for the test sample. It may have deviation for other test sample.

1.2 Objective

The following test report is prepared on behalf of *Firefly Lighting Co., Ltd.* in accordance with Part 2, Subpart J, and Part 18, Subparts A, B, and C of the Federal Communication Commissions rules and regulations.

This report is a Class II Permissive Change report. The EUT have the same PCB layout and circuit diagram as EUT of FCC ID: PGE-BH4, the difference is output power and concerned power components (T1 /T2/L1/Tr2) .The objective of the manufacturer is to determine compliance with FCC Part 18 limit requirements for Industrial, Scientific, and Medical Equipment.

1.3 Related Submittal(s)/Grant(s)

Original Report number is RSZ03102815, FCC ID number: PGE-BH, Which was granted at 1/12/2004.

1.4 Test Methodology

All measurements contained in this report were conducted with MP-5, FCC Methods of Measurements of Radio Noise Emissions from ISM Equipment, February 1986. All radiated and conducted emissions measurement was performed at Bay Area Compliance Laboratory Corp. The radiated testing was performed at an antenna-to-EUT distance of 3 Meters.

1.5 Test Facility

The Open Area Test site used by Bay Area Compliance Laboratory Corporation to collect radiated and conducted emission measurement data is located in the back parking lot of the building at the back parking lot of the building at 230 Commercial Street, Sunnyvale, CA 94085 USA.

Test site at Bay Area Compliance Laboratory Corporation has been fully described in reports submitted to the Federal Communication Commission (FCC) and Voluntary Control Council for Interference (VCCI). The details of these reports has been found to be in compliance with the requirements of Section 2.948 of the FCC Rules on February 11 and December 10, 1997 and Article 8 of the VCCI regulations on

December 25, 1997. The facility also complies with the radiated and AC line conducted test site criteria set forth in ANSI C63.4-2001 and FCC MP-5.

The Federal Communications Commission and Voluntary Control Council for Interference has the reports on file and is listed under FCC file 31040/SIT 1300F2 and VCCI Registration No.: C-1298 and R-1234. The test site has been approved by the FCC and VCCI for public use and is listed in the FCC Public Access Link (PAL) database.

Additionally, Bay Area Compliance Laboratory Corporation is a National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) accredited laboratory, under the National Voluntary Laboratory Accredited Program (NVLAP). The scope of the accreditation covers the FCC Method - 47 CFR Part 15 - Digital Devices, IEC/CISPR 22: 1998, and AS/NZS 3548: Electromagnetic Interference - Limits and Methods of Measurement of Information Technology Equipment test methods under NVLAP Lab Code 200167-0.


2.1 Justification

The EUT was tested under normal mode as used by a common (typical) user.


2.2 Equipment Modifications

No modifications were made by BACL to ensure the EUT to comply with the application limits and requirements.

3 - CONDUCTED EMISSIONS TEST DATA

3.1 Measurement Uncertainty

All measurements involve certain levels of uncertainties, especially in field of EMI. The factors contributing to uncertainties are spectrum analyzer, cable loss, and LISN.

Based on NIS 81, The Treatment of Uncertainty in EMI Measurements, the best estimate of the uncertainty of any conducted emissions measurement at BACL is ± 2.4 dB.

3.2 EUT Setup

The setup of EUT is according with MP-5 measurement procedure. The specification used was the FCC Part 18 limits.

The EUT was connected to the power cord extension and placed on the center of the back edge on the test table.

The power cord extension was connected with 120 VAC/60 Hz power source.

3.3 Spectrum Analyzer Setup

The spectrum analyzer was set with the following configuration during the conduction test:

Start Frequency.....	450 KHz
Stop Frequency	30 MHz
Sweep Speed.....	Auto
IF Bandwidth.....	10 KHz
Video Bandwidth.....	10 KHz
Quasi-Peak Adapter Bandwidth.....	9 KHz
Quasi-Peak Adapter Mode.....	Normal

3.4 Test Procedure

During the conducted emission test, the power cord of the power cord extension was connected to the auxiliary outlet of the first LISN.

Maximizing procedure was performed on the six (6) highest emissions to ensure that the EUT is compliant with all installation combination.

All data was recorded in the peak detection mode. Quasi-peak readings were only performed when an emission was found to be marginal (within -4 dB μ V of specification limits). Quasi-peak readings are distinguished with a "Qp".

The EUT was tested under the normal modes during the final qualification test to represent the worst case results.
