To whom it may concern:

The enclosed documents constitute a formal submittal and application for a Class II Permissive change / Reassessment for a WiFi device with IEEE 802.11abgn 2x2 client with 2.4GHz RF4CE 802.15.4 transmitter pursuant to the following rules:

Subpart C of Part 15 of FCC Rules (CFR 47), Intentional Radiators Subpart E of Part 15 of FCC Rules (CFR 47), UNII Devices

The application is for a new model variant, the HR54-700. The HR54-700 is a variant on the HR44-700, already FCC approved. The 802.11 radio was moved from a separate daughter card to the motherboard. The radio components remained unchanged. In addition, the motherboard was modified to allow for different A/V interface ports. The RF4CE radio was completely unchanged. Based on these changes, only spurious emissions were evaluated. Compliance with FCC Part 15 Subpart B was handled separately.
