I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) Kindly examine the Internal Photographs you submitted with this filing. The FCC is very insistent in having all RF shields removed and the underlying circuitry available for viewing. Please review your photos, remove all shielding and photograph again.
- 2.) Please conform that a second certificate as a Class B Computer Peripheral should be issued for this device.
- 3.) The Tune-Up description lists a maximum power of .282W while Form 731 only requests a power of .199W. This is worrisome because the SAR values for the head are approximately .4dB from the limit while the RF power has a discrepancy of almost 1dB. Please confirm the highest power available for this device. FYI: Please take care in the units used for power measurement (ERP/ EIRP/ conducted, etc.)
- 4.) Serial number for the dipole used for validation appears to be missing on pp. 32 of part 1 of the SAR report. Please review.
- 5.) What is the distance between the phantom and this device for testing during body worn testing? A photograph with ruler demonstrating the separation distance between body and EUT would be helpful. FYI: Manual claims 0cm separation distance but the photograph appears to show some distance between phone and phantom.
- 6.) Kindly provide a more complete description of the holster used in testing. Does this accessory contain any metallic components?
- 7.) What is the voltage and current through the final amplification stage as required in Part 2 of the Rules?
