Portable exposure SAR Exemption Calculation using a separation distance of 5 mm:

As per Clause 4.3.1.1 of KDB 447498 D01 v06:

$$\left(\frac{\text{max.power of channel,including tune-up tolerance,mW}}{\text{min.test separation distance,mm}}\right) \times \left(\sqrt{f (GHz)}\right) \le 3.0$$

$$\left(\frac{3.39\,\mathrm{mW}}{5\,\mathrm{mm}}\right) \times \left(\sqrt{2.440(GHz)}\right) \le 3.0$$

 $1.059 \le 3.0$ (complies)

The EUT complies with the exemption limits for routine evaluation based on frequency and separation distance as per Table 1 of RSS-102 Issue 5 March 2015. The EUT max power is below 4 mW exemption limit given for the separation distance less than 5 mm.

All calculations were based on maximum radiated output power that was calculated from the measured worst case peak field strength of 100.5 dBuV/m @ 3 meters.
