In general, filings with SAR from USB-dongle transmitters installed directly in host-product can be processed by TCBs. FCC 3G SAR procedures must be applied, or if not applicable follow PBA procedures where appropriate.

In accordance with KDB pub. no. 447498 and Oct06 FCC-TCB notes, applications should be filed at FCC for case of SAR from USB-dongle transmitter attached via cable between displaced host and with device mounted standalone under phantom.

Incomplete filings are automatically deleted from system after some time period - EASAdmin may have other advice if needed.
