Dear Mr. Johnson, Please find below the answers to your questions.

- 1) A frequency hopping list sample was added to the product technical description. A revised file "WipLL-5.8_technical_description_rev1" was uploaded on October 21, 2003.
- 2) A revised file "WipLL-5.8_technical_description_rev1" includes a 1.33 Mbit/s rate for Hybrid mode.
- 3) Actually 62 channels are used in the device. A missed channel F62 was added to revised file "WipLL-5.8_technical_description_rev1"; revised test report AIRRAD_FCC.15529_rev2 (pages 9, 11, 133) was uploaded on October 21, 2003.
- 4) According to the Airspan statement the product is intended for point-to-multipoint operations, hence, reduced limits were used throughout the testing.
