

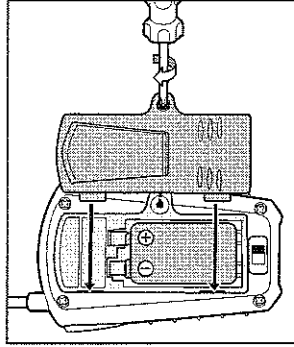
## BATTERY INSTALLATION

Unscrew the battery cover with a Phillips head screwdriver (not included). Install 1 "3V" alkaline battery in the orientation (+/-) shown into each unit. For best performance, use only alkaline batteries.

Replace battery cover and tighten screw. Replace the batteries if sounds play slowly or distort.

### BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION

- In exceptional circumstances batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:
  - Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
  - Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the product before being charged (if designed to be removable).
  - Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision (if designed to be removable).
  - Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
