I have the following comments on this application:

- 1.) The label does not contain the full FCC ID. It would be helpful to supply a line drawing of just the label with the complete FCC ID: as it will appear on the device.
- 2.) There is nothing in the reported measurements or test description to indicate radiated measurements were made through the required frequency range specified in 15.33(a).
- 3.) Please advise your client that a Part 68 application must be filed pursuant to 15.214(b). It would also be prudent to observe the other provisions of 15.214(c) and (d). In general, the label statement could easily appear in the manual, or as a supplement to the device when shipped, while the security provisions could be added as a separate document to the Operational Description

Everything else looks in order. I await your response.
