

FCC Rules and Regulations Part 1.1307, 1.1310, 2.1091, 2.1093: RF EXPOSURES COMPLIANCE

The manufacturer does not specify any antenna to be used with this device.
This transmitter is designed to be used in a fixed locations.
The antenna(s) used for this device are fixed-mounted on outdoor permanent structures.

RF exposure compliance is handled during licensing by the responsible FCC bureau(s). The installer of the antenna to be used with this transmitter may be required to perform an MPE evaluation and an Environmental Assessment (EA) of the location at the time of licensing per CFR 47 Part 1.1307. Additionally, fixed mounted antennae that are co-located with other antennae must satisfy the co-location requirements of Part 1.1307, for satisfying RF exposure compliance.
