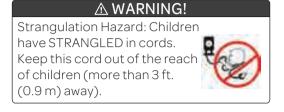

Screen On/Off

This feature allows you to turn the monitor screen off while still hearing audio from the Baby Unit. Simply press the **Screen On/Off** button for one second to turn the screen on or off.

Important: When the monitor is in battery mode, the screen will automatically turn off after 8 ninutes; this helps to conserve battery pow To turn screen back on, press the Screen On/Off button for one second.

Charging the Battery

The Parent Monitor has an internal. non-replaceable, Li-ion rechargeable battery Charge the battery by connecting the Parent Monitor to a power outlet using the USB power adapter provided. Battery Indicator:

With both units on, push and hold the Talk button on the Parent Monitor. Your baby will hear what

you are saying until you release the Talk button

Sound Indicator Lights and Volume

The Sound Indicator Lights on the Parent Monitor erve two purposes: 1) The default shows the level of sound coming

into the monitor from the Baby Unit. A quiet baby = green lights; a loud baby = red lights. 2) When the Volume Keys (+) (-) are pressed, the lights briefly show the volume level that comes out of speaker in the Parent Monitor: there are 6 volume levels.

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
