Shadow-2X

Shadow-2x: Installation of Batteries

1. Switch the power OFF.
2. Open the battery cover using a screwdriver (not included).
3. Take out the battery compartment and install 4 new 1.5V AA batteries with correct polarity (+/-) as shown inside the battery compartment.
4. Insert the battery compartment back and fasten the battery cover.

Transmitter: Installation of Batteries

1. Switch the power OFF.
2. Open the battery cover.
3. Install a new 9V battery with correct polarity (+/-) as shown inside the battery compartment.
4. Close the battery cover.

How to play:

1. Match the transmitter with the Shadow-2x Channel (Channel A or B or C).
2. Switch ON the transmitter, the transformation button will light up.
3. Switch ON the Shadow-2x.
4. Use the levers and buttons of the transmitter to control the movement, transformation of Shadow-2x

A. Movement

- i. Push the left / right lever up or down to move the Shadow-2x.



B. Transformation

- i. Press the transform button to transform Shadow-2x into different mode.



Shadow-2X

Performance Tips:

1. Do not drive on grass, sand, or go through water.
2. Do not drive in windy or rainy weather.
3. Avoid colliding with hard surfaces.
4. Switch OFF the Shadow-2x and transmitter when not in use.
5. Remove all batteries from the Shadow-2x and transmitter when not in use.
6. The operating range can be affected by a variety of factors:
 - a) Weak transmitter battery, or under-charged batteries.
 - b) Interference from other items that emit radio frequency signals such as another R/C item on the same frequency, CB radios, cordless phones, high voltage transformers, etc.
7. Make sure all missiles insert into the launcher tightly.
8. Check if there is foreign object inside the Shadow-2x before transformation each time.

Cautions :

1. Do not pick up the Shadow-2x while its in motion.
2. Do not pick up the Shadow-2x by holding the wind shield or the rear wing.
3. Do not bend the shelf and body of the Shadow-2x.
4. Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from the wheels.

Battery use :

1. Alkaline batteries are recommended to use.
2. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
3. Do not mix alkaline, standard or rechargeable batteries.
4. Do not mix old and new batteries or different type of batteries.
5. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be charged.
6. If rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.
7. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the product before they are charged.
8. Be sure to insert batteries with the correct polarities and always follow the battery manufacturer's instructions.
9. Remove all batteries from the vehicle and transmitter when not in use.
10. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the product.
11. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
12. Dispose of batteries properly. Do not dispose the batteries in fire — it may cause them to explode or leak causing injury or damage
13. Batteries change must be only by adults.

FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

1) Why does my Shadow-2X not start?

- Make sure the transmitter and the vehicle are turned on.
- Check to make sure the batteries are not drained.
- Make sure the batteries are installed per polarity indicators.
- Make sure all wheels are not obstructed by any foreign objects.

2) Why does my Shadow 2X make unusual noises?

- Check to make sure the batteries are not drained.
- Check to make sure all wheels are not obstructed by any foreign objects.
