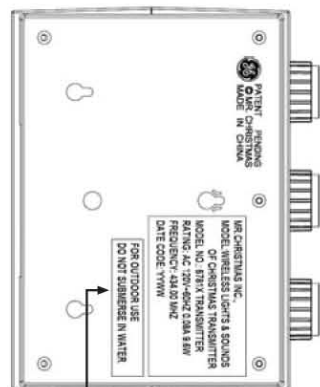

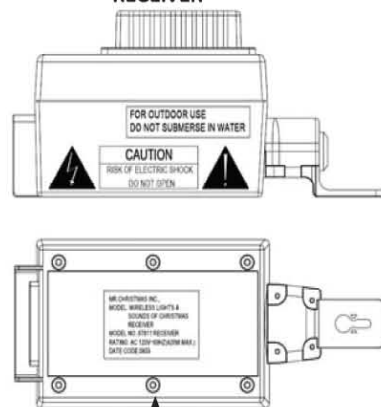

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Your WIRELESS LIGHTS AND SOUNDS OF CHRISTMAS® has been designed to give many seasons of trouble free operation. In the event that a problem does occur, please refer to the following chart for suggested solutions.

PROBLEM	LIKELY CAUSE	SOLUTION
No music	No power	Make sure the adaptor is plugged into a working outlet and the output plug is properly plugged into the jack
	Faulty light string/bulbs	Check light strings for burnt out bulbs Suggestion: Check your light strings before installation
	Transmitter is too close to the ground	Raise the Transmitter so that it is at least 6 inches above the ground
No lighting	Receiver has been unplugged and re-plugged into a power source	Wait until the next song when the receiver will begin to pick up the signal
	Transmitter is not on	Turn the volume dial on
	Receivers are too far away from the Transmitter	Place each Receiver within 50 feet of the transmitter
	Receivers are too close to each other	Allow for at least 24 inches space between Receiver
Light show results are not as desired	–	Review Installation instructions for how to best set up your light show

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical products, basic precautions should always be followed including the following:

### 1. READ AND FOLLOW ALL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS.

- Do not use seasonal products outdoors unless marked suitable for indoor and outdoor use. When products are used in outdoor applications, connect the product to a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupting (GFCI) outlet. If one is not provided, contact a qualified electrician for proper installation.
- This seasonal use product is not intended for permanent installation or use.
- Do not mount or place near gas or electric heaters, fireplaces, candles or other similar sources of heat.
- Do not secure the wiring of the product with staples or nails, or place on sharp hooks or nails.
- Do not let lamps rest on the supply cord or on any wire."
- Unplug the product when leaving the house, or when retiring for the night, or if left unattended.
- This is an electric product - not a toy! To avoid risk of fire, burns, personal injury and electric shock it should not be played with or placed where small children can reach it.

#### USE AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

#### USER SERVICING INSTRUCTIONS

#### CONNECTING LIGHTING STRINGS

The wattage (W) rating of a lighting string can be found on a tag located with 6 in. plug. If connecting a lighting string that does not have a Wattage (W) rating to the receiver, calculate the wattage as follows: Multiply the current (\_\_\_ A), which is on the lighting string tag, by 120. For example: For a lighting string rated 120 V, 60 Hz, 0.2 A,  $0.2 \times 120 = 24$  Watts. Add the wattage of each lighting string together for a total of 420 Watts or less. Do not exceed 420 Watts.

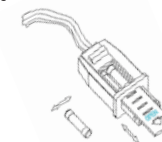
#### FUSE REPLACEMENT

Your WIRELESS LIGHTS AND SOUNDS OF CHRISTMAS® comes with spare fuses to replace burnt-out fuses located in the plug of each receiver. Be sure to replace a burnt-out fuse with a fuse of the same rating: 5A 125V UL listed fuse.

**CAUTION: BEFORE REPLACING, ALWAYS DISCONNECT THE POWER SUPPLY CORD FROM THE POWER SOURCE**

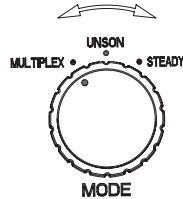
**RISK OF FIRE.** Do not replace attachment plug. Contains a safety device (fuse) that should not be removed. Discard product if the attachment plug is damaged.

- Grasp plug and remove from the receptacle or other outlet device. Do not unplug by pulling on cord.
- Open fuse cover. Slide open fuse access cover on top of attachment plug towards blades.
- Remove fuse carefully. Turn fuseholder over to remove fuse.
- Risk of fire. Replace fuse only with 5 Amp, 125 Volt fuse (provided with product).
- Close fuse cover. Slide closed the fuse access cover on top of attachment plug.



### OPERATION continued

3. The **MODE** switch allows you to choose different lighting effects. In **Multiplex**, lights flash and dance to the music. In **Unison**, lights flash simultaneously to the rhythm of the music. In **Steady**, the lights will all stay steady on while the music plays.



### LIGHTING SCHEMES

There are many ways to arrange your light show using the WIRELESS LIGHTS AND SOUNDS OF CHRISTMAS®. One easy way to conceptualize your use of this product in the MULTIPLEX setting is to think of your outdoor lighting décor within "Zones." Below are two possible examples of arrangements of the four "Zones."



#### SYMMETRICAL SET-UP

Zone 1 – Left Eaves/Bushes  
Zone 2 – Right Eaves/Bushes

Zone 3 – Center Eaves/Bushes  
Zone 4 – Reindeer/Light Sculptures

Plug Zone 1 into Receiver #1, Zone 2 into Receiver #2, Zone 3 into Receiver #3, and Zone 4 into Receiver #4. Zones 1 and 2 will get the most lighting action, while Zones 3 and 4 will "highlight" the music with slightly less lighting action.

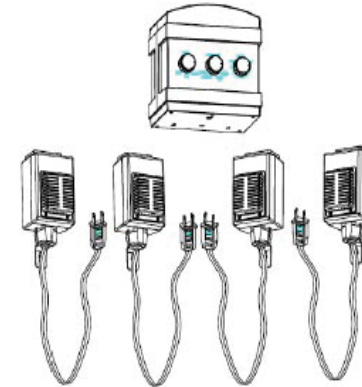
#### PANORAMIC SET-UP

Zone 1 – All Eaves Zone 3 – Front Bushes  
Zone 2 – Door/Rear Bushes Zone 4 – Reindeer/Light Sculptures

Plug Zone 1 into Receiver #1, Zone 2 into Receiver #2, Zone 3 into Receiver #3, and Zone 4 into Receiver #4. Zones 1 and 2 will get the most lighting action, while Zones 3 and 4 will "highlight" the music with slightly less lighting action.

### DESCRIPTION

Thank you for purchasing the WIRELESS LIGHTS AND SOUNDS OF CHRISTMAS® from Santa's Best Craft, LTD. This product consists of one main **transmitter** and four **remote receivers**. As the Transmitter plays the music of 40 holiday songs, the four remote receivers are activated and facilitate a light show that flashes and dances to the music when combined with your holiday lighting.



Total capacity is: 1,680 Watts - Each receiver has a maximum capacity of 420 watts

**WARNING: DO NOT CONNECT LIGHTS STRINGS OR SETS IN EXCESS OF THE ABOVE CAPACITY.**

### INSTALLATION

Note: If you have not yet assembled your outdoor lighting, it may be useful to check your light strings before assembly to identify missing/faulty bulbs.

1. **BEFORE INSTALLING:** Consider how to best set-up your light show...

#### The Concept

Your WIRELESS LIGHTS AND SOUNDS OF CHRISTMAS® will allow you to set up an exciting holiday light show outside your home. A main **transmitter** is plugged into an outdoor GFI equipped outlet and communicates with four **remote receivers** that are plugged into other outlets across your decorating area eliminating the need for expensive and bulky extension cords. Your light strings and light sculptures are plugged directly into the **remote receivers** and will respond to the music played by the **transmitter**.

#### Capacity

The total capacity of the WIRELESS LIGHTS AND SOUNDS OF CHRISTMAS® is 1,680 Watts. Each receiver has a capacity of 420 Watts. Please refer to the packaging, instruction manual or the warning tags on your holiday lighting for the exact wattage of each item being plugged into a receiver. In order not to exceed the 420 watts per receiver, you must add up the wattage of each item being plugged into the receiver to attain the total wattage.

## INSTALLATION continued

### Lighting "Action"

This product delivers an exciting light show by using a transmitter to activate four remote receivers which are plugged directly into your light strings or sculptures. Each of the four receivers delivers a different level of lighting "action" when the unit is operated in **Multiplex** mode (lights flash and dance to the rhythm of the music). The receivers are labeled 1 through 4, with #1 delivering the most lighting action and #4 delivering the least (i.e. these lights will remain off more than the light string(s) attached to receiver #1 when in **Multiplex** mode). Please see page 7 for suggested lighting schemes.

### Arrangement of Unit

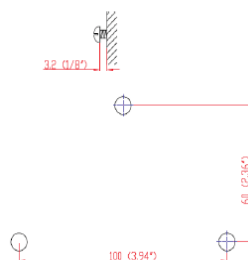
Your WIRELESS LIGHTS AND SOUNDS OF CHRISTMAS® can operate along 100 ft. of your house front! Each receiver may be placed up to 50 ft. away from the transmitter. Please allow for at least 24 in. of space between each receiver for ideal functioning.

**NOTE: RECEIVERS CAN ONLY BE UP TO 50 FEET AWAY FROM TRANSMITTER.**

## 2. INSTALLATION OF TRANSMITTER

### A. Wall Mounting

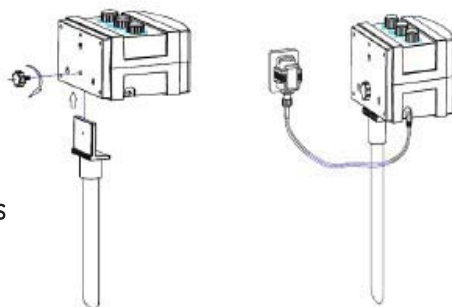
1. Insert the three included screws on the mounting surface according to the diagram at the right. Leave 1/8 in. space between the screw head and the surface.
2. Mount the unit by inserting the three screws into the keyholes at the back of the unit.
3. Make sure the unit is secure.
4. Plug the unit into an outdoor power source.



**NOTE: TRANSMITTER SHOULD BE AT LEAST 6 INCHES OFF THE GROUND**

### B. Ground Staking

1. Slide the ground stake into the base of the unit.
2. Secure with the included screw. Turn until tight.
3. Secure the stake (with attached unit) into the ground and make sure that it is stable.
4. Plug the unit into the outdoor power source.

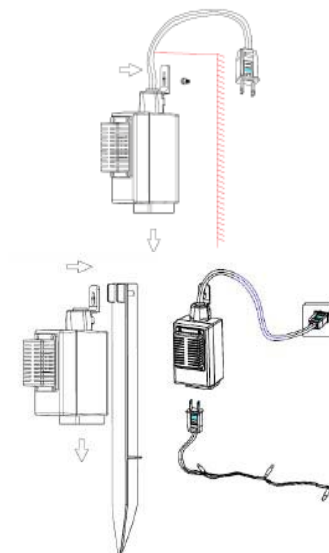
## 3. INSTALLATION OF RECEIVERS

### A. Wall Mounting

1. Insert the included screw on the mounting surface. Leave 1/8 in. space between the screw head and the surface.
2. Mount the unit by inserting the three screws into the keyholes at the back of the unit.
3. Make sure the unit is secure.
4. Plug the unit into an outdoor power source.

### B. Ground Staking

1. Slide the **remote receiver** into the ground stake as shown in the picture at the right.
2. Secure the stake into the ground and make sure that it is stable.
3. Plug your light strings into the bottom of the receivers as shown in the picture.

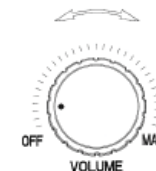

## OPERATION

1. To turn on the unit, turn the volume dial on the **transmitter** to the MAX. position. To turn off the unit, turn the volume dial to the OFF position. Please note: The light strings may not turn off immediately and may flash for up to a minute after the **transmitter** has been turned off. This is normal.



2. The **SONG SELECT** dial allows you to choose among groups of songs in different musical styles including **Light Fantastic**, **Joyful Season**, **All Christmas Songs** (both Light Fantastic and Joyful Season). Please see section entitled SONG LIST for a complete list of songs played by your WIRELESS LIGHTS AND SOUNDS OF CHRISTMAS®.
