

**I. Description**

Thank you for purchasing Mr. Christmas' **SERVING SANTA**. A remote controlled Santa delivers Christmas gifts to everyone in the room. Just put the present on his tray and guide him with the remote control.

**II. Unpacking the unit**

Your **SERVING SANTA** has been carefully packed to assure that it will reach you in perfect condition. To unpack, follow these steps:


1. Carefully open the box as shown in FIG.1a & 1b.
  2. Un-twist the twist tie to free the remote control from the box. (See FIG.1b.)
  3. Firmly grasp the base of the unit with both hands and carefully free it from the box.
- NOTE: DO NOT HOLD THE UNIT BY THE TRAY OR THE ARMS.
4. The unit is now free of the packaging. Be sure to save the packaging for storage of your **SERVING SANTA** from season to season.


### III. To install the batteries

1. Un-screw and remove the battery compartment cover 'A' (located at the bottom of the round base) as shown in FIG.IIa & IIb.
2. Repeat step 1 to remove the battery compartment cover 'B'.
3. Insert four "D" batteries (not included) into the battery compartments making sure to align "+" and "-" as marked inside the battery compartments. (See FIG.IIc.)
4. Un-screw and remove the remote control battery compartment cover as shown in FIG.IIIa & IIIb.
5. Align a "9V SIZE" battery (not included) with the 9V battery connector as shown in FIG.IIIc. Then firmly press to connect the "9V SIZE" battery with the 9V battery connector.
6. Put the "9V SIZE" battery with the 9V battery connector back into the battery compartment oriented as shown in FIG.IIIId.





CONNECTOR****FIG.IIIb****IV. Operation**


Follow these instructions to get maximum enjoyment from your **SERVING SANTA** :

1. Carefully place the figure on the floor.
2. Turn the power switch (located at the rear of the round base) to the "ON" position. (See FIG.IV.)
3. Push the remote control **TURNING BUTTON** (See FIG.V) to turn the figure. Release the **TURNING BUTTON** to stop the figure turning. Push the **FORWARD BUTTON** (See FIG.V) and the figure will move in the desired direction. Release the **FORWARD BUTTON** to stop the figure moving.
4. Turn the power switch to the "OFF" position when not in use.

**NOTE:** THE FIGURE MAY BE ACTIVATED BY ANOTHER RADIO CONTROLLED ARTICLE OR RADIO SIGNALS IN THE VICINITY AND CAUSE UNDESIRE MOVEMENT. PLEASE TURN THE POWER SWITCH TO THE "OFF" POSITION IMMEDIATELY WHEN NOT IN USE OR UN-ATTENDED.

5. Remove all the batteries for storage of the unit to avoid battery leakage.
6. PLEASE NOTE: THIS ITEM IS DESIGNED TO WORK ON REGULAR LENGTH CARPET PILE, BUT WILL WORK NORMALLY ON THICK PILE EXCEPT IT WILL MOVE SLOWER.

**V. Trouble shooting**

Your **SERVING SANTA** has been designed to give many seasons of trouble-free operation. In the event that a problem does occur, please refer to the following chart for suggested solutions.

<b>Problem</b>	<b>Likely Causes</b>	<b>Solution</b>
Figure does not move	1. No power	1.1. Make sure the batteries are installed properly and aligned with the "+" and "-" polarity as marked inside the two base battery compartments.
		1.2. Push each battery so that the "+" polarity of the battery contacts that end of the battery compartment.
		1.3. Check the battery connection of the remote control making sure the polarities of the "9V SIZE" battery are matching that of the 9V battery connector as shown in FIG.11c., and are securely connected.
	2. Exhausted batteries	2. Replace with new batteries.
	3. Power switch is "OFF"	3. Turn the power switch to the "ON" position.
	4. Figure is too far away	4. Approach the figure or place the figure closer to you.
	5. Figure obstructed	5. Remove obstruction or place the figure away from obstruction.
Figure moves slowly	1. Thick carpet pile	1. Item is designed to work on regular length carpet pile, but will work normally on thick pile except it will move slowly.
