- Adding Dell mobile host notebook model: T02G (Dell marketing name: Latitude ST).
- The T02G can be collocated with one of the following transmitters:
 - PPD-ARS263 (WLAN/Bluetooth Transmitter)
- The E396 has two-way authentication implemented for user's installed modules.
- The E396 restricts the power in some bands when used with the T02G BIOS to meet SAR. The details are provided as part of the Theory of Operation.
