This letter is to state that the FCC OET LABS has authorized in principle a variance in the KDB447498 SAR testing procedure for USB Dongle Modem: FCC ID: PKRNVWMC1000.

This Variance is as follows:

Test the Dominant USB Horizontal Position in a Laptop with a phantom distance of 0.5" or less

Test One USB Vertical Position in a Laptop with a phantom distance of 0.5" or less

Test 2<sup>nd</sup> USB Vertical Position on a short (<12") USB cable with a phantom distance of 0.5" or less.

Test Secondary Horizontal Position on a short (<12") USB cable with a phantom distance of 0.5" or less.

All results shall show compliance to a SAR level of <1.6W/kg.

This is to advise that we are in full compliance with the Anti-Drug Abuse Act.
