The 2GHz Band ODU (FCC ID: PKTODUBBR) is a non-consumer product that is not available to the general public. The equipment requires professional installation and is fitted with security fixings to prevent unauthorised access when the equipment is installed in locations that may be accessible to the general public e.g. mounted on a vehicle.

The equipment does not contain any field serviceable parts so equipment servicing or repairs are on a return to manufacturer basis. The equipment required to access the internal components is not provided to distributors, installers or users.

To control information marked as 'Proprietary Information' all requests for data transfer must be reviewed and authorised by Export Control. The Export Control department will verify the

request and confirm the proposed recipient is party to a valid Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) before processing the transfer request.
