Question #1: In accordance with ANSI C63.4, Section 6.1.3, external ports of EUT shall be connected with one of each type during the tests. As indicated in the test setup photos as well as in the test report, there are several external ports did not connect with typical device. Please redo radiated and conducted emission tests by connecting external peripherals for each type of external ports. In addition, the minimum test configuration for ITE is outlined in section 11.2 of ANSI C63.4. In addition to those peripherals to be connected to EUT, the host computer needs to connect to at least two different I/O protocols.
