After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) It appears that the antenna is actually contained in a plastic cover. Please provide internal photographs of the antenna.
- 2) The users manual section 1, mentions a detachable antenna. Page 31 of the users manual also mentions a detachable antenna. However this product appears to only contain a single integrated antenna. Please explain and if necessary correct the users manual.
- Section 1 and 2-2 of the users manual appear to describe the device as directly connecting to the computer (i.e. laptop) without the cable. This device appears to only connect to a computer via a USB cable. Please comment and correct the users manual if necessary.
- 4) FYI. Proposed Grant Conditions:

Power output listed is conducted. The antenna used for this transmitter must be installed to provide a separation distance of at least 20 cm from all persons and must not be co-located or operating in conjunction with any other antenna or transmitter. End-users and installers must be provided with antenna installation instructions and transmitter operating conditions for satisfying RF exposure compliance.
