





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1.1 External View









2.1.1 Basic Operation


2.2 Turn on and turn off

Turn on: Press  by 3 seconds

Turn off: Press  by 3 seconds or more until the unit turns off.



2.3 Make and receive calls


2.3.1 Make a call whit numeric keyboard

When the phone is in standby, enter the desired number using the numeric keypad and press .

To end the call press  twice

2.3.2 Receive calls

1. When you receive a call, the screen displays the caller's number and name if it has been included in the phone book. press  to answer, or press "Mute" to turn off the ringer, then press "Reject" to reject the call (busy signal). You can press  to

reject de call directly.
2. Press  to fend the call.

2.4 Activate SOS function



To activate **SOS** function press **SOS** button up.

NOTICE: To turn off SOS function press **SOS**



button down.

2.5 FM Radio



1. While in standby mode, press the "+" button on the Volume key for 5 seconds.



2. With the Menu key, tune up or down the desired station.,

3. Using the "+" and "-" button on the Volume key, volume up and down respectively
4. To exit the FM radio function, press .

2.6 Enable/disable music player

1. While in standby mode, press the "-" button on the Volume key for 5 seconds.
2. With the menu key , up and can select the desire song
3. With the "0" key pauses or actively playing music again.
4. Using the "+" and "-" on the Volume key, volume up and down respectively.
5. To exit the music player function., Press .

2.7 Keyboard Lock and Unlock

2.8 Writing text message (SMS)

1 While in standby mode, press the action Key



, "SMS".

2. Select "Write Message" and press "OK".

3. Select "SMS" and press "OK".

4. Write your message using the keypad. For a list of



special character then press the star key, Select the desired character with the menu button and click "OK".

5. Once you finish the message, press the left soft key "Options".

6. Choose the option "Send to" and press "Select".

7. With the Menu key, choose "Enter Number" and enter the number you want to send the message or, choose "Phone Book" and select the contact you want to send the message. Then press the "OK" button. To add more recipients, repeat this 7step again.

8. Press the "Options" button.

9. With the Menu key, choose "Send" and press "Select". Then the phone sends your message.

2.10 Delete text message

2. With the menu key , up and down, choose "Inbox" or "Drafts" or "Outbox" or "Sent messages" as the folder from which you want to delete the message.




Then press "OK".

3. With the menu key , up and down, choose the message you want to delete and press "Options".



4. With the menu key , up and down, choose "Delete". And with the Left action Key , press select.



5. Press the left action key  "Yes".



2.11 Setting SOS options

1. While in standby mode, press the Menu Key



, up or down and select "Settings", then press



the Left action Key, "OK." With the menu key, choose "Options SOS" and press "OK"

2. In Option 1) SOS On / Off SOS, enable or disable the SOS pressing Left action Key "OK"

3 To record or erase the numbers that will be sended the SOS message and they will be called, press the Left action Key on the "Number of SOS", then press the same button on the options "Number 1" to "Number 5" , type the number or delete it, then press "OK".

4. With the Right action Key "Back" returns to the "SOS Message", enter with the Left Soft Key "OK", type the SOS message you want and press "Save" and then Yes

2.12 Disable/ enable pronunciation numbers

1. While in standby mode, press the Menu Key

2.15 Record Videos

3. With the Right action Key will completely stop the recording and the phone will ask you if you want to save the video. Press "Yes" or "No" as desired.

5. With the red key  can exit the camera application.

2.16 Watch Videos

1 While in standby mode, press the Menu Key




, up or down and select "Multimedia" then

press the Left action Key , "OK".

3. Pressing the "+" and "-" volume key , can be able to see the list of recorded videos.

4. To play a video, on the video you want press the Left Soft Key "Options", then press the same button "Select" on the "Play".

2.17 Setting date and time

1. While in standby mode, press the Menu Key

2.18 Change SIM card PIN

2.19 Calculator

2.21 Write multimedia message

1. While in standby mode, press the Left action Key



, "SMS".

2. Choose "Write message" and press "OK".

3. Choose "MMS" and press OK".

4. Press "Options"

5. Choose "Add image "or" Add sound "or" Add Video ", then press" OK "

6. Press "Select"



7. With the menu key, up or down and select "Phone" or "Memory card" and press Open".



8. With the menu key, up or down and select "My Music" or "Videos" or "Photos" and press open



9. With the menu key, up or down and select the file you want to send and press"OK"

10. Press "Options".

11. Choose the option "Send to" and press "Select".

2.22 Set send and receive multimedia messages (MMS)

This configuration must be performed by the technical staff of the telephone service provider, please refer to this manual to a branch of your provider or ask for help from your provider.

- a. Besides, to send and receive multimedia messages, it is essential that: Your telephone service provider has enabled this feature for your telephone line.
- b. You have installed a MicroSD memory card in the phone.

Ensure the above before continuing with the setup.

Configuration steps for technical staff of the service provider.:


