- 1.) Please provide a revised Restricted Band Edge test per my earlier August 9, 2004 email.
- 2.) This filing seems a bit confused. You are asking for a Limited Modular Approval, but it is not how and in what way the filing is limited. All the basic requirements of DA 00-1407 seem to be in place. Please explain how this qualifies as a Limited Modular Approval.
- 3.) Regardless of whether this is a full or limited modular approval; the Manual appears written for the general public. This is not allowed only modular approvals to OEM integrators who can install the final installation in a proper, safe manner are permitted. Please provide a detailed installation procedure showing how OEM integrators can satisfy the RF category "Mobile" radio frequency exposure guidelines.
- 4.) Does the Applicant request any exhibits be held Confidential? If so, please supply a Confidentiality Request letter. Typical exhibits to be considered usually include Block Diagram and Schematics.
- 5.) Kindly provide larger and clearer Internal Photographs. The supplied photos are not completely satisfactory.
