Zaxcom, Inc. requests modular approval for the XRT transmitter module. The module meets the approval requirements as per FCC 47 CFR Section 15.212. Please see the checklist below:

- a) The XRT radio module has its own radio frequency circuitry shielded to prevent unintended radiation.
