





- **Step 2:** Insert the batteries as shown inside the battery compartment.




For Extra usage hours, use two AA batteries instead of two AAA Batteries.





Setup the Connection between the Receiver and the Mouse, Keyboard.

1. Plug the RF receiver into the USB port of your computer.



- 2. Insert the batteries into the mouse and keyboard, then follow the steps below.
- 3. If the mouse or the keyboard is not working, please put them into pair mode.

- 4. Pairing: Re-plug the receiver into the USB port of your computer, then press connect button of the moue and keyboard. If the mouse or keyboard does not work after 10 seconds, pair them again. (The receiver has auto pairing function).
- 5. When the batteries' power of the keyboard is low, the Low Power indicator will start to blink.
