Sorry, but I still have a few comments on this Application.

Referring to my March 28, 2005 comments.

- 1.) There appears to be no response to my question #4. If I have missed this, kindly refer me to where it appears in the filing. I acknowledge receiving the filing "Output power.pdf" but no information is presented to indicate if this is a measurement or simply the manufacturer's power settings for this radio.
- 2.) There appears to be an incomplete response to my question #6. If this data was supplied, kindly indicate where in the filing it may be located. I acknowledge test data was received in two fillies titled "Radiated Emission-2.4G.pdf" and "Radiated Emission-5G.pdf". Unfortunately it is not possible to determine any pass or fail criteria without full explanation of antenna correction factors, cable loss, etc. for all of the data presented above 1GHz. There are no limit lines presented in these additional plots. The plots are not labeled. It is not even possible to confirm if these are indeed radiated emissions plots, or just conducted emissions measured at the antenna terminals. It might even turn out that the presentation above 1GHz will show the noise floor of the instrumentation above the permitted limits. Please review the materials presented.
- 3.) An identical file is presented for both Operational Description and Block Diagram. This is allowed, however the Confidentiality Request must be modified. Please review. The same file cannot be listed as both Confidential and not-Confidential
