CONTENTS:

- 1 x Vehicle With Built-in Rechargeable Battery
- 1 x Transmitter Controller, 2 x AA Batteries

SAFETY TIPS:

- Toy surface may become hot and cause burns if the electronics get wet. DO NOT OPERATE this vehicle near/in/through water, snow, sand, grass or any wet or muddy surfaces.
- Never play this vehicle on streets! The streets are for real cars!
- Do not pick up vehicle while in motion.
- Always place the car gently on the floor by hand. Never throw the car onto the floor.
- Avoid collisions with walls, any hard objects, or human/animal bodies.
- Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from tires and wheel hubs.
- To avoid accidental operation, remove all batteries from controller when not in use.
- Do not play with the antenna wire, as it may cause bodily injury and product defect.
- Do not connect this toy with other power supplies.
- Do not insert any wire into electrical outlets.
- Be sure to rest your vehicle for at least 5 minutes after every 15 minutes of operations.

YOUR NEW R/C IS DESIGNED WITH A BUILT-IN RECHARGEABLE BATTERY. CONTROLLER IS DESIGNED TO WORK WITH 2 AA BATTERIES, BATTERIES ARE INCLUDED.

INSTALLING 2 BATTERIES INTO CONTROLLER (See Diagram 1)

Requires 2 (two) "AA" alkaline batteries (Included)

- Using a screwdriver (not included), remove the battery compartment door.
- Remove and properly dispose of the used batteries (if any).
- Insert the 2 "AA" batteries, with polarity (+/-) as shown inside battery compartment.
- Replace the battery compartment door and use a screwdriver to lock the compartment door.

BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION (CONTROLLER)

- Ensure that battery polarity is correct.
- It is recommended to use only Alkaline type batteries.
- Do not mix used and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Remove used batteries immediately.

- Remove controller batteries if R/C will not be used for a long period of time to prevent possible battery leakage.
- Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Do not short-circuit terminals.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries (or products containing non-replaceable batteries) in fire, as batteries may explode or leak.

CAUTION: BUILT-IN BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION

- The vehicle includes a non-replaceable battery. Do not open, disassemble or alter the vehicle in anyway.
- Built-in USB adapter is permanently attached to the vehicle. To protect your vehicle, only connect to USB certified port.
- Adult supervision is required when charging the vehicle.
- Never charge or store the vehicle in extremely hot or cold temperatures (about 104°F/40°C or below 14°F/-10°C) or beyond 60±25% related humidity. Don't charge or store the vehicle toy inside a parked car under the sun.
- Keep USB cable enclosed inside the chassis box after charging or before playing. DO NOT over extend or detach the cable.
- Charge battery in isolated area. Keep away from flammable materials.
- Do not expose to direct sunlight.
- Do not recharge the toy if it is hot. Allow it to cool before recharge.
- Do not drop or subject to strong impacts.
- Do not allow the batteries to get wet.
- Carefully read the instruction guide and use the batteries correctly.
- In the unlikely event of leakage or explosion use sand or a chemical fire extinguisher for the battery.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Routine examination for damage to the plug, enclosure and other parts. In the event of any damage, the toy must not be used with USB port until the damage has been repaired.
- This toy is not intended for children under 3 years old.

QUICK TIPS

- The included rechargeable battery is not charged prior to shipment and must be charged before the first use.
- When your vehicle starts to lose power, it may lose function or performance. It's time to recharge the batteries. Your vehicle's running time may change depending on your driving style.
- Radio interference can make your vehicle run abnormally. Interference can be caused by other R/C vehicles running on the same frequency; electrical wires, large buildings; or CB radios. Try to stay away from these!
- Point your transmitter controller antenna up – not down toward your vehicle. If your vehicle gets too far away, it won't work properly.
- Don't store your vehicle near heat or in direct sunlight. Always turn the switch to the off position when not in play.

CLEANING INSTRUCTION

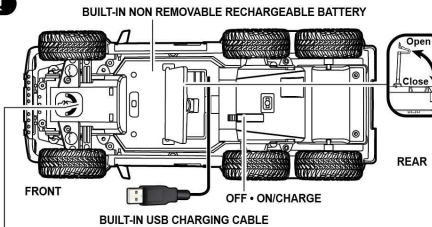
To clean, wipe excess dirt from toy. Wipe toy clean with damp cloth. Wipe dry. DO NOT IMMERSER IN WATER and DO NOT CLEAN VEHICLE WITH ANY CHEMICALS. Let the toy completely dry before playing.

- Contact your local waste management officials for information regarding the environmentally sound recycling and disposal of batteries and electronic toys.

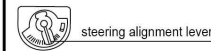
CHARGING THE R/C CAR

- BUILT-IN NON REMOVABLE RECHARGEABLE BATTERY**
- CHARGING THE R/C CAR:**
- Open the USB charging plug compartment door
 - Take out the USB plug
 - Make sure the switch is in the ON/CHARGE position
 - Locate a USB certified port from any of the devices specified on the Jada Charging Eco System Chart
 - Plug in the built in USB charging plug from RC vehicle to USB certified port
 - The LED light will start blinking to show it is charging
 - Once the LED light stays on, the RC vehicle is fully charged

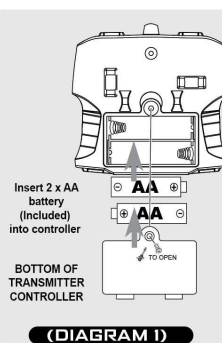


TO ADJUST STEERING ALIGNMENT

JADA HYPERCHARGERS CHARGING ECO SYSTEM

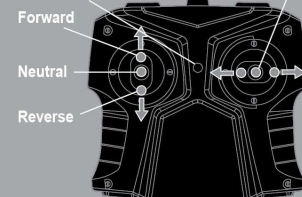

TROUBLE SHOOTING

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
Vehicle will not START	1. Power switch is off. Make sure to turn it on. 2. Batteries are drained. Charge batteries.
Vehicle does not respond to controls.	1. Transmitter controller battery is drained. Replace the controller battery. 2. Vehicle is out of range. Bring controller closer to the vehicle. 3. Interference from surrounding electrical machinery. Bring to a wide open space.
Vehicle does not drive straight.	1. Adjust the steering dial underneath the front axle, left or right, until the wheels point straight forward.
Vehicle does not move	1. Stop operation, switch off the power and rest your vehicle a few minutes. 2. Check the channels match on the vehicle and controller.
What does MHZ stand for and where can I find it?	MHZ stands for Megahertz, which is the frequency used to communicate between the vehicle and remote. MHZ is broken down to two frequencies, 27MHZ and 49MHZ. IT IS IMPORTANT TO NOTE, IN ORDER TO PLAY WITH 2 VEHICLES SIMULTANEOUSLY, EACH VEHICLE MUST HAVE A DIFFERENT MHZ. To locate what MHZ your vehicle is, it will be clearly marked on the front of all Jada RC packaging as well as on the back or bottom of the remote unit and underneath the actual vehicle.
Why does one remote controller control both vehicles when trying to play 2 RC vehicles at the same time?	Please double check that both remotes and vehicles are not the same MHZ (Megahertz) frequency. These should be denoted as either 27MHZ or 49MHZ. NOTE: IN ORDER TO PLAY 2 VEHICLES AT THE SAME TIME, EACH VEHICLE MUST HAVE A DIFFERENT MHZ.
