In regards to your recent TCB grant referenced above we kindly request that you provide the following additional information.

1) Explanation of reference level in and details of setup for Occupied BW plots. Plots suggests a maximum power of approximately 20 dBm. Other documents suggests power of 29.x, and 30.x dBm for 800 and 1900 MHZ respectively.

2) Clarification of the use of "SAR manual insert" under EAS exhibit 8. This statement could not be located in the user manual. Also, body-worn accessory language in the statement is not acceptable. It could be easily understood by a user to mean all SE accessories can be used. The language in the full user manual exhibit is acceptable for a body-worn statement.

3) Confirmation that no accessory covers mentioned on page 59 of 77 of the user manual contain metallic components/paint.

4) Strong justification for duplication of results for EMC and SAR results with FCC ID PXITR-G0702 recently granted. Provide justification that FCC IDs are identical equipment. The same serial numbers were used for testing under both grants. Retest as appropriate.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of the original e-mail date may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 2.917(c).
