




- 1 Charging/Notification light

To insert SIM and memory cards



- 1 Drag out the SIM card tray.
- 2 Insert the memory card in the correct orientation into the memory card slot.
- 3 Place the SIM card securely in the SIM card tray.
- 4 Gently push the SIM card tray back into the slot until it fits into place.

To turn on your device

1 Long press the power key until the device vibrates.

2 Wait a moment for the device to start.

To activate the screen

• Briefly press the power key.
