# 2 Test Configuration of Equipment Under Test


a. The EUT has been associated with peripherals and configuration operated in a manner tended to maximize its emission characteristics in a typical application. Frequency range investigated: radiation emission (1GHz to 40GHz). For radiated measurement, the measured emission level of the EUT was maximized by rotating the EUT on a turntable, adjusting the orientation of the EUT and EUT antenna in three orthogonal axis (X: flat, Y: portrait, Z: landscape), and adjusting the measurement antenna orientation, following C63.10 exploratory test procedures and find Z plane as worst plane. The worst case position of the EUT was investigated under two configurations: EUT with AC adapter and earphone, EUT with standalone. The EUT with standalone configuration was determined to be worst-case configurations; therefore, all final tests were performed on the EUT with standalone.

## 4.1.1 Limit of Maximum Conducted Output Power

For the band 5.725–5.85 GHz, the maximum conducted output power over the frequency band of operation shall not exceed 1 W.


#### 4.1.3 Test Procedures

The testing follows Method PM of FCC KDB 789033 D02 General UNII Test Procedures New Rules v02r01.

Method PM (Measurement using an RF average power meter):

- 1. Measurement is performed using a wideband RF power meter.
- 2. The EUT is configured to transmit continuously with a consistent duty cycle at its maximum power control level.
- 3. Measure the average power of the transmitter, and the average power is corrected with duty factor,  $10 \log(1/x)$ , where x is the duty cycle.
- 4. For MIMO mode, the measure-and-sum technique should be used for measuring the in-band transmit power of a device.

#### 4.2.1 Limit of Unwanted Emissions

    - VBW ≥ 1/T, when duty cycle is less than 98 percent where T is the minimum transmission duration over which the transmitter is on and is transmitting at its maximum power control level for the tested mode of operation.
- 2. The EUT was placed on a turntable with 1.5 meter for frequency above 1 GHz respectively above ground.
- 3. The EUT was set 3 meters from the interference receiving antenna which was mounted on the top of a variable height antenna tower.
- 4. The antenna is a broadband antenna and its height is adjusted between one meter and four meters above ground to find the maximum value of the field strength for both horizontal polarization and vertical polarization of the antenna.
- 5. For each suspected emission, the EUT was arranged to its worst case and then adjust the antenna tower (from 1 m to 4 m) and turntable (from 0 degree to 360 degrees) to find the maximum reading.
- 6. For testing above 1 GHz, the emission level of the EUT in peak mode was 20 dB lower than average limit (that means the emission level in average mode also complies with the limit in average mode), then peak values of EUT will be reported, otherwise, the emissions will be measured in average mode again and reported.



## WIFI 802.11a (Band Edge @ 3m)








