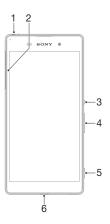
Device basics



1 Charging/Notification light

- 2 Nano SIM/Memory card slot cover
- 3 Power key/Fingerprint sensor
- 4 Volume/Zoom key
- 5 Camera key
- 6 Charger/USB cable port



To insert a memory card

- Open the nano SIM/Memory card slot cover.
- 2 Place the memory card in the memory card slot in the correct orientation as shown in the illustration.
- 3 Close the cover.

To insert the nano SIM card

- If you drag out the nano SIM card holder while the device is powered on, the device restarts automatically.
- Open the nano SIM/Memory card slot cover.
- Using your fingernail or a similar object, drag out the nano SIM card holder.
- 3 Place the nano SIM card in the holder, then insert the holder into to the slot.
- 4 Close the cover.
- Make sure you insert the nano SIM card and the holder in the correct orientation as shown in the illustration.

To turn on the device

- Make sure that the battery is charged for at least 30 minutes before you turn on the device for the first time.
- Press and hold down the power key () until the notification light flashes once.

To activate the screen

Briefly press the power key (1).

Screen protection

Before using your device, remove the transparent protection film by pulling up on the protruding tab.

The use of non Sony-branded screen protection accessories may prevent your device from working properly by covering sensors, lenses, speakers, or microphones and can also invalidate the warranty.

- 1 Open the nano SIM/Memory card slot cover.
- 2 Using your fingernail or a similar object, drag out the nano SIM card holder.
- 3 Drag out the label tray in the same way. The CE mark and FCC ID are displayed on the label tray.

2 Wait a while for the device to start.
