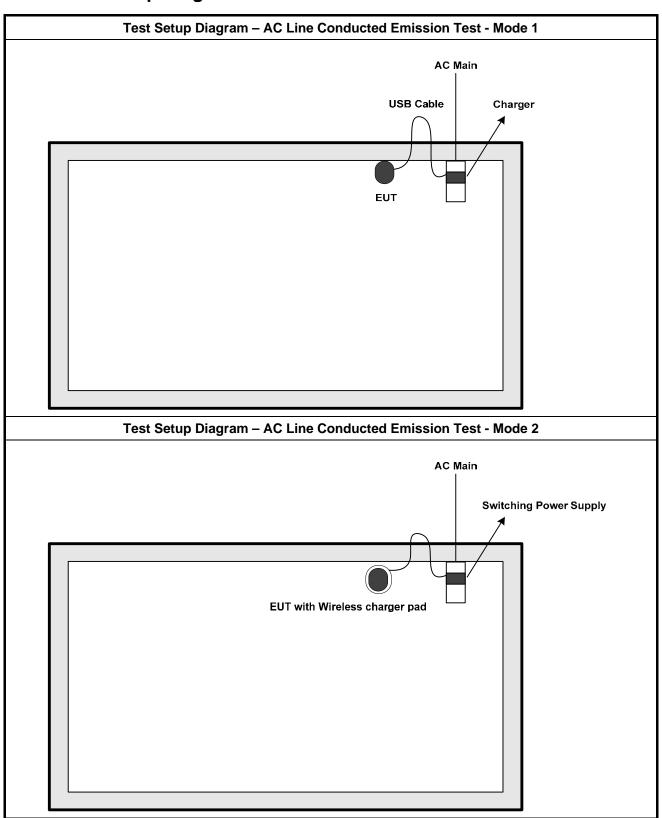

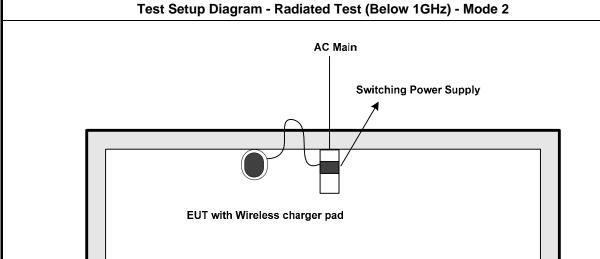
Test Setup Diagram - Radiated Test (Below 1GHz) - Mode 1

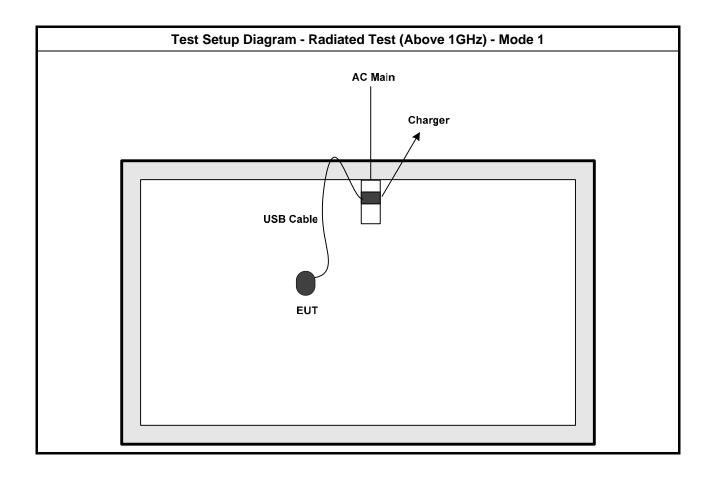

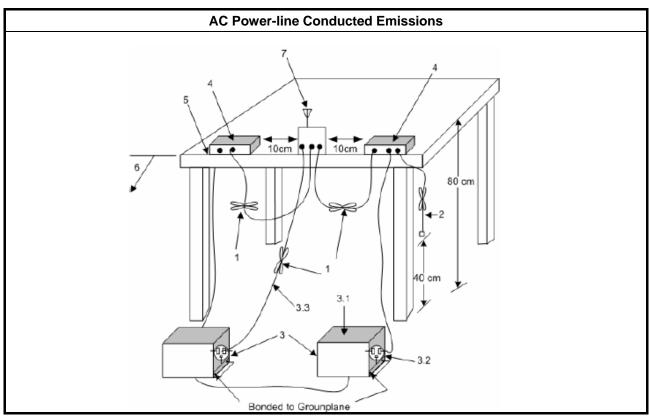

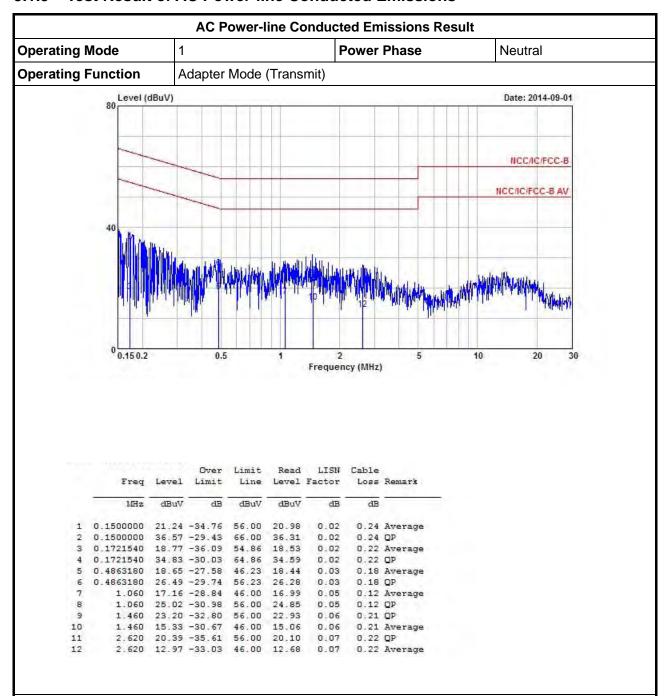

#### **Test Result of AC Power-line Conducted Emissions**

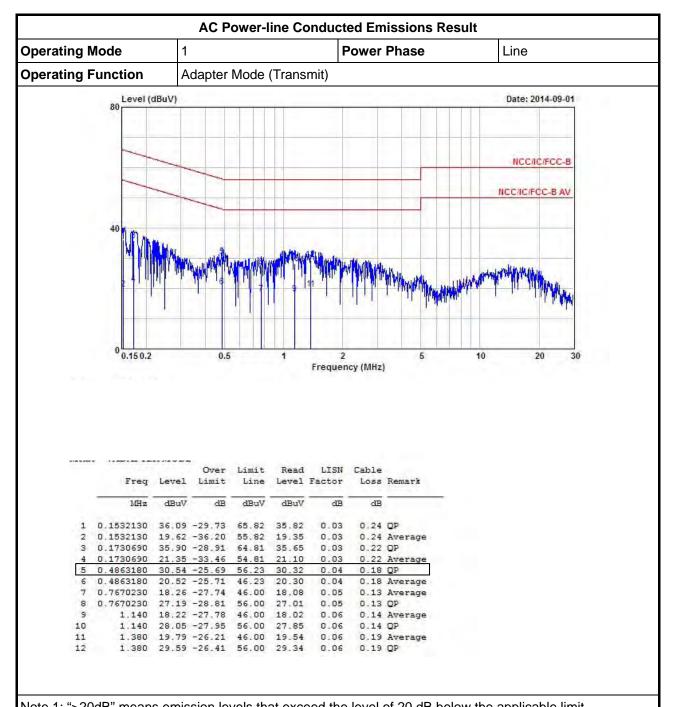

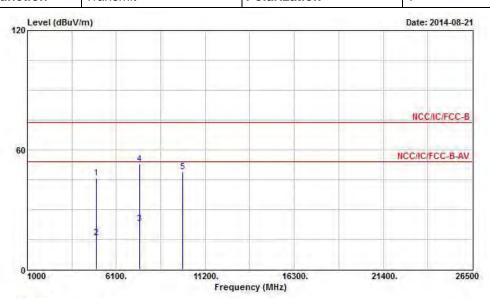


Transmitter Radiated Unwanted Emissions (Above 1GHz)

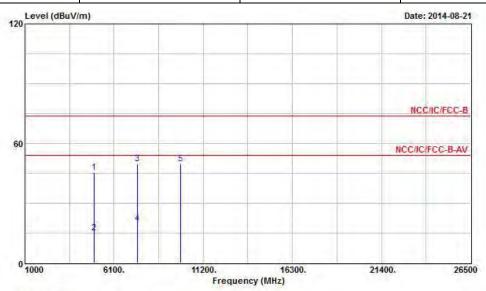
