

6 Radiated Emission Test

- 6.1 Test Method and test Procedure:
- (1) The EUT was tested according to ANSI C63.4 –2009. The radiated test was performed at Timeway Laboratory. This site is on file with the FCC laboratory division, Registration No.899988
- (2) The EUT, peripherals were put on the turntable which table size is 1m x 1.5 m, table high 0.8 m. All set up is according to ANSI C63.4-2003.
- (3) The frequency spectrum from 30 MHz to 1 GHz was investigated. All readings from 30 MHz to 1 GHz are quasi-peak values with a resolution bandwidth of 120 kHz. For measurement above 1GHz, peak values with RBW=VBW=1MHz and PK detector. AV value with RBW=1MHz, VBW=10Hz and PK detector. Measurements were made at 3 meters.
- (4) The antenna high is varied from 1 m to 4 m high to find the maximum emission for each frequency.
- (5) Maximizing procedure was performed on the six (6) highest emissions to ensure EUT compliance is with all installation combinations. All data was recorded in the peak detection mode. Quasi-peak readings was performed only when an emission was found to be marginal (within -4 dB of specification limit), and are distinguished with a "QP" in the data table.
- (6) The antenna polarization : Vertical polarization and Horizontal polarization.

Middle Channel: Horizontal




Middle Channel :: Vertical





7.0 20dB Bandwidth Measurement

- 3. Measure the highest amplitude appearing on spectral display and record the level to calculate results. 6. Repeat above procedures until all frequencies measured were complete.







1. Condition: Low Channel









1. Condition: Low Channel







8. Maximum Peak Output Power

8.1 Regulation

According to §15.247(b)(1), for frequency hopping systems operating in the 2400-2483.5 MHz band employing at least 75 non-overlapping hopping channels, and all frequency hopping systems in the 5725-5850 MHz band: 1 watt. For all other frequency hopping systems in the 2400-2483.5MHz band:0.125 watts. According to §15.247(b)(4), the conducted output power limit specified in paragraph (b) of this section is based on the use of antennas with directional gains that do not exceed 6 dBi. 9. Carrier Frequency Separation

9.1 Regulation
