

1. Introduction

Kanex AirBlue™ – Portable Bluetooth™ Music Receiver

The Kanex AirBlue™ is a Bluetooth based music receiver that simply enables you to wirelessly play, listen and control all your favorite media from your iPod touch, iPhone, iPad, MP3 player, or Smart phone through your home stereo or speakers.

Features:

- Play your iPod Touch, iPhone, iPad, or any other Bluetooth enabled device wirelessly through your home stereo receiver or speakers
- Control the music, podcasts and movies directly from your Bluetooth enabled device
- Bluetooth connection has a 33ft. range for virtually unlimited wireless listening.

2. Package Contents

1. Main Unit (x1)
2. Mini USB Charger (Power Adapter) (x1)
3. 3.5mm to RCA Stereo Cable (x1)
4. 3.5mm to 3.5mm audio cable.

3. Connecting Your AirBlue™

1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the headphone jack on the AirBlue.
2. Connect the other end of the audio cable (3.5mm or RCA) to an audio input on your home stereo receiver. **Please review your receiver's manual for more information.*

4. Discoverable Mode

In order to pair your AirBlue™ with a device you must first put the AirBlue™ into "discoverable mode". This mode allows other Bluetooth enabled devices to detect, communicate, and connect with the AirBlue™.

- Holding the Pause/Play button for only 4 seconds while the AirBlue™ is off will turn the AirBlue™ on (Not Discoverable mode). The LED light will begin to flash in slow intervals, about 1 flash per second.
- Holding down the Pause/Play button for 6 seconds will put the AirBlue™ into discoverable mode; Blue LED light will begin to flash in fast intervals, about 4 flashes per second.

5. Pairing Your AirBlue™

Before attempting to pair your device make sure the AirBlue™ is in discoverable mode.

Go to the Bluetooth manager of your iPod touch, iPhone, or iPad by following these steps:

- Tap "Settings"
- Tap "General"
- Tap "Bluetooth"
- Search Bluetooth devices and select "Kanex"
- Enter "0000" when the player asks for the PIN code. This will allow the iPhone to pair with the Kanex AirBlue™.
- Once paired, the blue LED light on the Music receiver will flash once. The Blue LED light will stay on when a connection is established.

NOTE: Some devices, such as the iPhone, will connect immediately after pairing so the LED will stay on. Other devices, such as laptops, may ask you if you wish to connect and the LED will go off after pairing until a connection is established.

6. Troubleshooting

You can quickly resolve most problems with your Kanex AirBlue™ by following the advice in this section.

Can't hear any music from my stereo speakers.

Solution(s):

- Make sure the Kanex AirBlue™ has power/ fully charged and is on.
- Make sure an audio cable is correctly and firmly connected to the AirBlue™.
- Make sure one of the two supplied audio cables is correctly and firmly connected to the receiver and the stereo.
- Make sure the Receiver is powered and on.
- Make sure the stereo volume is set to a comfortable listening level.
- Make sure you are within range of the Receiver, and that your iPod Touch, iPad, or iPhone is connected via Bluetooth technology with the Receiver.

Factory Reset:

- Press & hold the Pause/Play button for 13 seconds while the unit is **off**.

7. Safety Warnings

- The Kanex AirBlue™ requires full concentration and both hands to install.
- Do not use the unit near water (for example, a bath tub, wash bowl, kitchen sink, laundry tub, wet basement, swimming pool, or other areas located near water).
- Clean only with a dry cloth; Make sure the device is powered off.
- Do not install near any heat sources such as stoves or other appliances (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
- Protect the charging cord from being walked on or pinched, particularly at the plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit the AirBlue™
- Only use Attachments/Accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- Unplug/Power off the device when not in use.
