- Parent's Portable Unit has a folding belt clip and a battery compartment (9V battery not included) for true portability and convenience. An amber LED within the Sound Light Window indicates low battery power.





Thank you for buying the 49 MHz Baby's Quiet Sounds™ Clearview Tower Monitor from Summer Infant. This unique product provides you with one of the most comprehensive systems for monitoring your baby. The Baby's Quiet Sounds™ Clearview Tower Monitor allows you to hear your baby, just like other nursery monitors. What makes this system unique is that it also visually alerts you to baby's sounds – by utilizing antennas that change color as baby's sounds increase in volume.

Babies almost constantly produce sounds the entire time they rest or play. These sounds are healthy and normal. This product monitors those sounds – even the small ones. If baby's sounds escalate to crying, the Towers and the Window on the Portable Unit will progress from green to amber to red, alerting you to the need for immediate attention.









PORTABLE PARENT'S UNIT

### QUICK SET UP:

Read the complete instruction manual for more detailed instructions and explanations.

- Place Baby's Unit in nursery and place near the crib (do not place in crib or within child's reach). Plug in AC Adaptor. To turn the Unit on, turn the Channel selector to Channel A.
- Place Parent's Unit in another room. Plug in AC Adaptor. Set Channel Selector to Channel A. Set desired volume level.
- Test for sound pick up from nursery. Have an adult speak from softly to loudly. Towers and Window will change from green to amber to red with increasing voice volume. Set Parent's and Parent's Portable Units to desired volume levels. Set light intensity levels on Baby's and Parent's Units.
- The Parent's Portable Unit can be used in a third room by plugging in the AC Adaptor or after installing a 9V battery, can be clipped to an adult's belt and carried for maximum convenience.





### SET UP & USE:

### **Baby's Unit**

Place the Baby's Unit in the nursery near the crib on a flat surface, such as a dresser, bureau or shelf (not in the crib or within child's reach). Insert AC Adapter into the AC Adapter Jack on the back of the Baby's Unit as shown in Figure A. Plug the AC Adapter Jack AC Adapter into a standard electrical outlet.



To turn the Baby's Unit on, position the Channel Selector (A/OFF/B) to channel A.

Use the Hi/Low Buttons on the front of the Unit to increase or decrease the intensity of the Soft Glow Night Light Tower. The Tower will always glow with a soft light.



### **Parent's Unit**

Place the Parent's Unit in the room from which you want to monitor your baby (ie. bedroom or living room). Plug an AC Adapter into the AC Adapter Jack on the Parent's Unit and the other end into a standard electrical outlet.

Position the Channel Selector (A/OFF/B) to channel A. The Sound Light Tower will glow and change from green to amber to red, indicating that the Unit is on. Set the OFF/LOW/HI switch to LOW or HI to your preference of light intensity for the Sound Light Tower. We suggest using Hi for daylight and Low for night time.

Set Volume to desired level using Up/Down buttons.

### **Parent's Portable Unit**

Place the Portable Unit in another room, away from the Parent's Unit (i.e. garage or family room). Plug an AC Adapter into the AC Adapter Jack on the Portable Unit and the other end into a standard electrical outlet.

Position the Channel Selector (A/B) to channel A. Turn the Unit on with the On/Volume Dial. The Sound Light Window will glow and change from green to amber to red with increasing voice volume.

Set Volume to desired level using Up/Down buttons.



You should be able to clearly hear all levels of sound coming from the Baby's Unit through the Speaker on each Unit. Test both channels for best performance, but ensure that all Units are on the same channel. If the The Sound Light Tower or the Sound Light Window doesn't change color or no sound comes from the Speaker of the Parent's Unit or Portable Unit when you perform these tests, check to make sure all cords are fully plugged in and connected and batteries are fresh. Make sure all Units are turned on.

### To Use the Parent's Portable Unit in Portable Mode Installing the battery:

For use in portable mode the Parent's Portable Unit requires one 9V battery. Slide and pivot the belt clip to access the battery compartment door. Remove the battery

compartment door and insert the battery as shown in Figure C. Be sure to orient the + and - properly.

### Replacing the Back-up Battery in the Parent's Unit Installing the battery:

Remove the battery compartment door and insert 9V battery as shown in Figure D. Be sure to orient the + and - properly. The

battery will provide power to the Parent's Unit for convenience.

- Use only a 9V alkaline battery.
- Change battery on a regular basis.
- To conserve battery power, use AC Adapter whenever possible. Remove battery during long periods of non-use.
- If a battery is exhausted, remove it immediately from the Parent's Unit and replace with a fresh battery.
- Properly dispose of exhausted batteries.

#### **Belt Clip:**

For convenience and portability, you can clip the Parent's Portable Unit to your belt or waistband after a battery has been installed. An amber LED in the Sound Light Window will indicate low battery power. The belt clip can also be used as a table stand.
