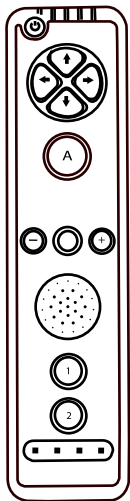

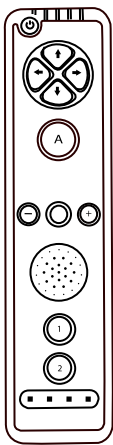


Cautions

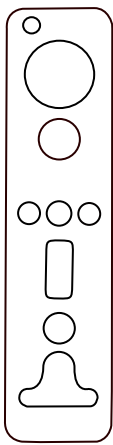
- Do not disassemble. This will void any and all warranty and may be extremely hazardous.

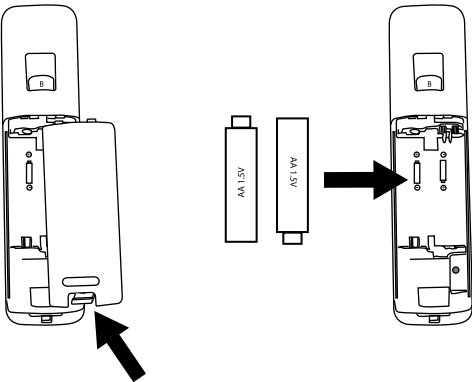

Operation Guide

1. Install batteries

- Remove the Battery Compartment cover.
- Install two AA batteries into the Battery Compartment. Make sure the direction is correct. And replace the Battery Compartment cover.

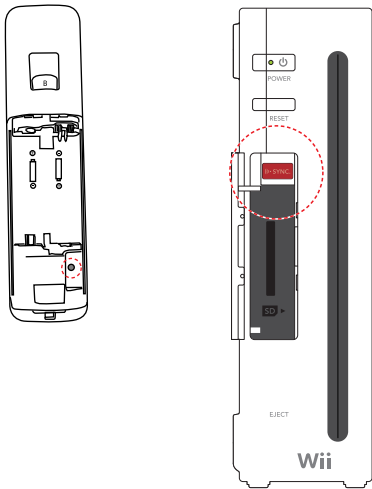


2. Synchronizing the remote with gaming console.

You have to synchronize your remote with the gaming console when you the first time use it.

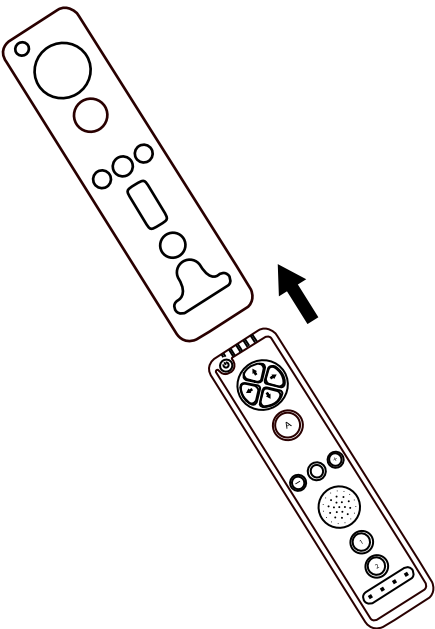

- Turn on your gaming console. Remove the battery cover on the back of the remote. Press and release the SYNC. button inside the cover. The Player LEDs will blink.
- Open the SD Card Slot cover on the front of the gaming console. Press and release the SYNC. button on the inside of the compartment.
- When the Player LED blinking stops, connection is complete. The LED that is illuminated indicates the player number.
