Hi Roland,

The current connection manager (carrier connection software) for Sprint does not allow the CDMA/EVDO module to operate at the same time as the $802.11\ WLAN$ module.

When you launch the Sprint connection software a dialogue box will pop up telling the user that simultaneous operation is not allowed and the Sprint software application disables the 802.11 module while the CDMA/EVDO module is being used. Once the user disconnects the Module from the carrier and closes the Sprint connection application the 802.11 device is then re-enabled and the CDMA/EVDO module becomes disabled.
