We, Motion Computing Incorporated hereby authorize Bay Area Compliance laboratory Corp to act as a laboratory for testing and test report generation for the following project: FCC ID: Q3QHWNVWEX725, Model: T006 {Marketing Name: LE1700}

This project is a Permissive Change II submission for the purpose of replacing the existing CDMA/EVDO module with the latest version of CDMA/EVDO module offered by Novatel Wireless. The reason for the change is due to Novatel Wireless replacing their existing CDMA/EVDO module Expedite E720 with the Expedite E725 due to an "end of life" on the Expedite E720. The only difference between the two modules is supporting GPS over the main antenna whereas the E720 supported GPS over the diversity antenna. Motion Computing does not support GPS, but as a result of the change and end of life of the E720 we were left with no choice but to update to the latest revision of CDMA/EVDO module.

We affirm that between BACL and Motion Computing Incorporated, any difference in understanding, including test plan, measurement methods, applicable standards and relevant procedures and processes have been resolved prior to commencement of testing activities.
