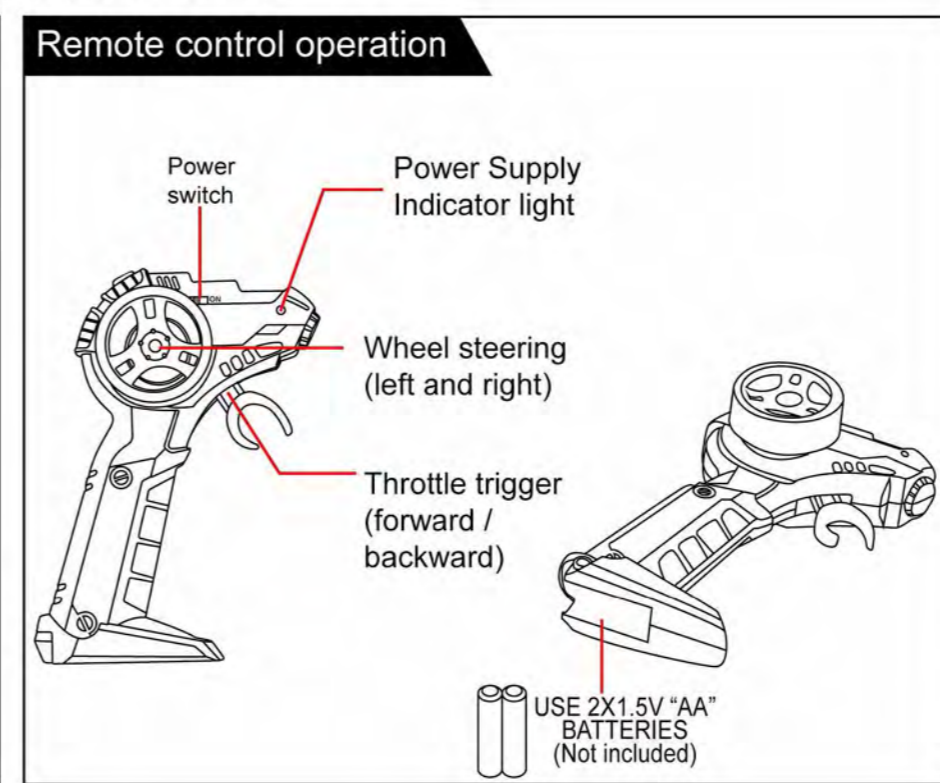
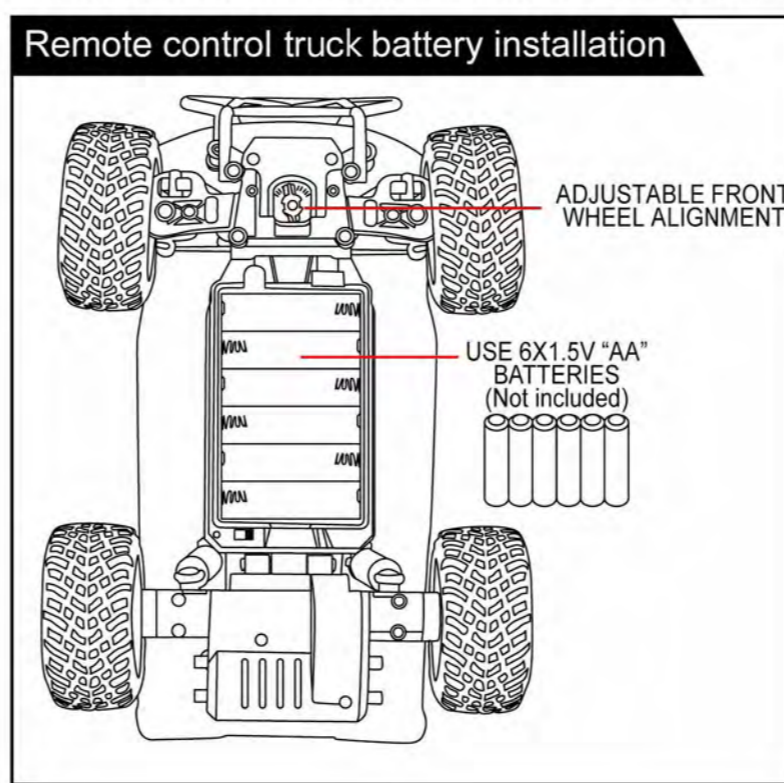

- Instructions for battery operated truck**
- 1) Batteries should only be inserted or changed by an adult.
  - 2) Switch the truck to the "off" position before inserting batteries.
  - 3) Insert batteries correctly in the manner shown elsewhere on the truck or packaging.
  - 4) Only use the same type of battery - Do not mix brands or types.
  - 5) Replace all batteries at the same time with new ones.
  - 6) Do not leave batteries in the truck for long periods of time when it is not in use.
  - 7) Do not use rechargeable batteries.
  - 8) Dispose of used batteries safely - Do not throw on a fire or attempt to open up the outer case.
  - 9) At all times keep small batteries which could be a choking hazard to children out of their reach. Batteries are harmful if swallowed.
  - 10) Seek medical advice if a small battery has been swallowed.
  - 11) Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
  - 12) The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
  - 13) Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the truck before being charged.
  - 14) Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
