386MI Central locking system user's manual

Functions

1. Arm

Press A button on the transmitter, the doors will lock automatically and the engine will be immobilised. The LED light will turn on and flash twice every 2 seconds.

2. Disarm

Press & button on the transmitter, the doors will unlock automatically and the immobiliser will be disarmed. The LED light will turn off.

3. Emergency override

When the transmitter is lost or has failed, to override the system while the car is armed.

- a. Open the door with the key
- b. Press the override button 3 times
- c. Hold down the button for 2 seconds on the 3rd press.

The system will then be overridden and the LED light will turn on/off slowly.

4. Transmitter programming

Press the override button for 2 seconds, the LED light will turn on, press \(\text{A} \) button once, the LED light will flash twice to indicate the successful programming of this transmitter; press \(\text{A} \) button of another transmitter once, the LED light will flash twice to indicate the successful programming of this transmitter. Only two transmitters are functional for this system.
