Please correct your modular request letter to reflect modular not LMA (i.e. 'authorization as a modular approval specific to mobile devices such as access points and routers")
2. Please note that the manual states the device operates at $14 \mathrm{dBm}+/-1 \mathrm{~dB}$ (see page 35 of the manual). The report clearly states that the device is a 19.97 dBm and 17.88 dBm conducted (see page 6 and 41 of the report. Please make your manual reflect the actual conducted values reported +/- 1dB.
3. Please note that your operational description is not correct. The application is for modular approval, not limited modular approval. Please correct the operational description to reflect the actual application for the device.
4. Please confirm that channels 12 and 13 (those channels above 2462 MHz ) cannot be software selected by the installer or user.
