

RF Exposure Declaration

FCC ID: Q95ER13

According to FCC document 447498 entitled "Mobile and Portable Device RF Exposure Procedures and Equipment Authorization Policies", for portable transmitters, where the source-based time-averaged output power is ≤ 60/f(GHz) mW, a device may be used in portable exposure conditions with no restrictions and routine RF Exposure evaluation is not required.

The cardo BK-1 is a Bluetooth device and is defined as a portable device for General Public Use and the maximum peak output power is (19.95 mW) which falls below the specified 24.2-25 mW level.

We hereby declare that the cardo BK-1 is not subject to the routine RF Exposure evaluation as per section 2.1093 of the FCC rules due to its low level of output power.
