


RADIO FREQUENCY RADIATION EXPOSURE

MPE calculation:

Test setup 1:



Formula:

S=EIRP / $4\pi R^2$

S = Power Density (mW/cm²) EIRP = Radiated power (mW) R = distance for body (cm)

Calculation:

= 4.77mW/ $4 \pi 0.62$ mW/cm²

 $S = 0.987 \text{mW/cm}^2$

Notes:

- 1. The unit will be mounted at least 0.58cm away from the body.
- 2. The carrier power EIRP 4.77 mW was the worst case peak level measured.
- 3. Antenna Gain of 0dBi stated by manufacturer.

S

Limit

The limit of Power density for the General Population/ Uncontrolled Exposure is 1 mW/cm².

Result

The EUT meet the 1 mW/cm² limit.
