

# LifeShadow Ears User Manual

Thank you for choosing LifeShadow Ears. LifeShadow Ears is a very simple way to capture audio and have it wirelessly transmitted to a LifeShadow account for later recall. Place one or more LifeShadow Ears devices at convenient locations throughout your house and always have an 'ear' that's ready to capture a quick thought for safe-keeping.

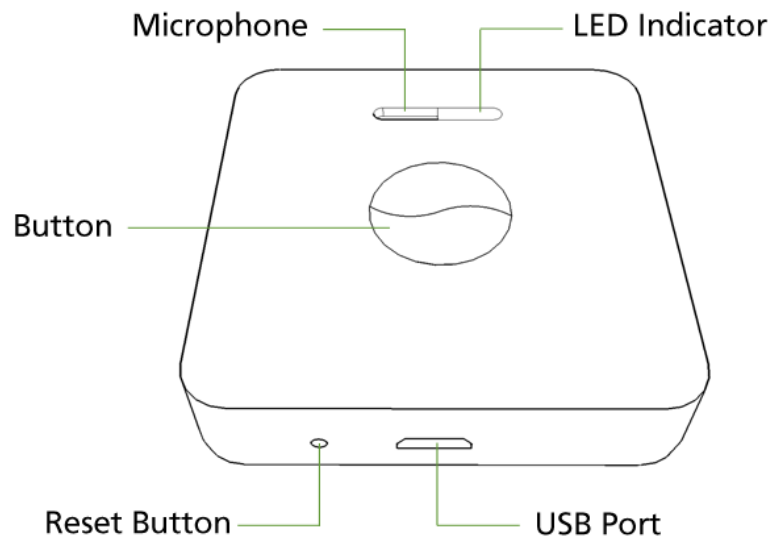

## At-a-glance

The primary components of the Ears device are shown below.



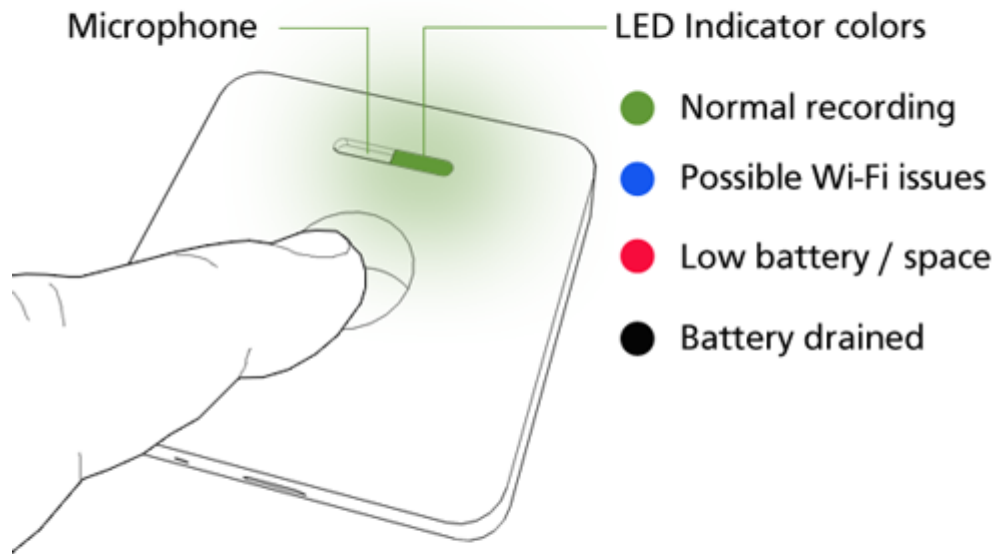
## **Attaching / Mounting the Device**

Inside the Ears enclosure are two magnets that allow the device to be attached to metal surfaces (like on a refrigerator door).

In addition, two industrial strength hook and loop adhesive strips are provided to attach the device to non metallic surfaces. Place one of the adhesive strips in the recess on the back of the device and place the other on the surface to which the device will be mounted. The device will be held securely in place - but can also be temporarily removed for periodically charging the battery.

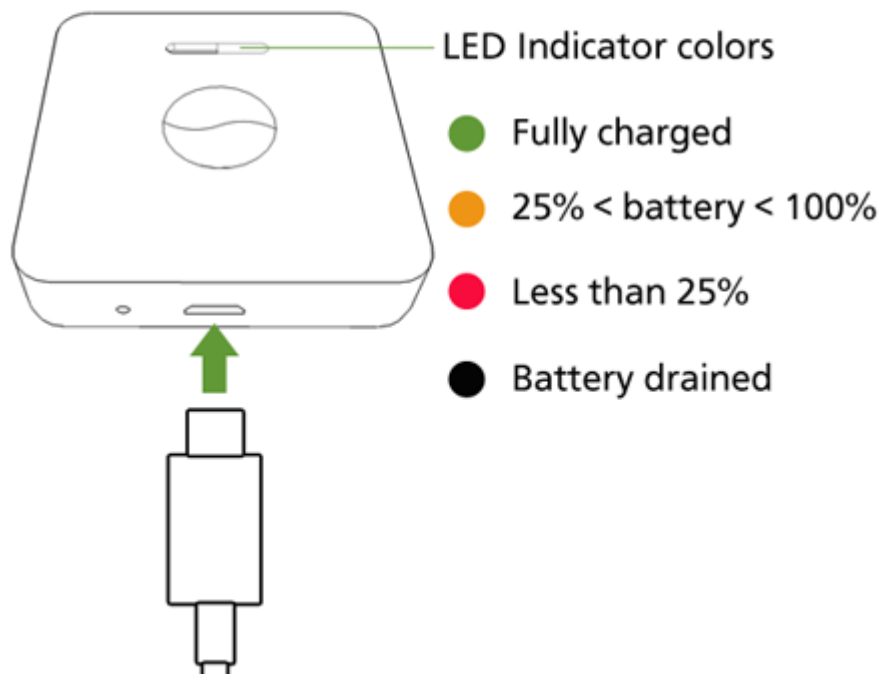
## Normal Device Use

To add a new message, press and hold the button and speak into the microphone. Release the button when done. The message will be automatically uploaded to the LifeShadow account.



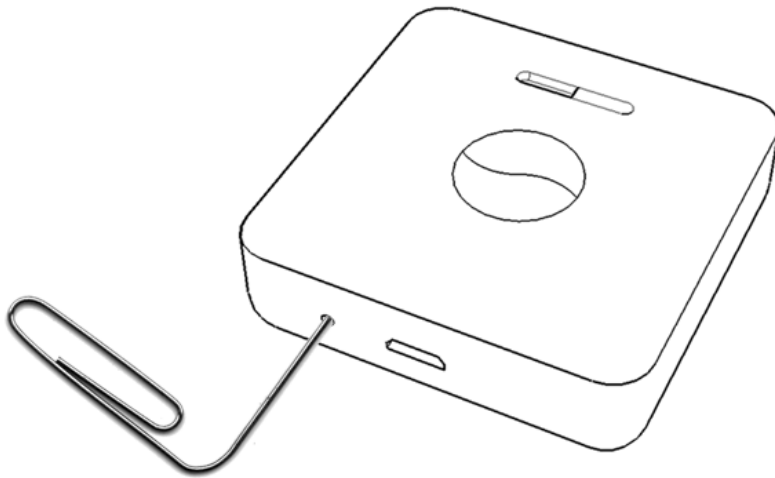
## Charge the Device

Plug one of the USB cable into the device and the other into either a power adapter or to a powered computer USB port. The LED indicator will show one of the following colors during charging.



## Reset the Device

In the rare event that the device becomes unresponsive, even after charging, insert the end of a paper clip into the reset slot as shown, until you feel a light click.



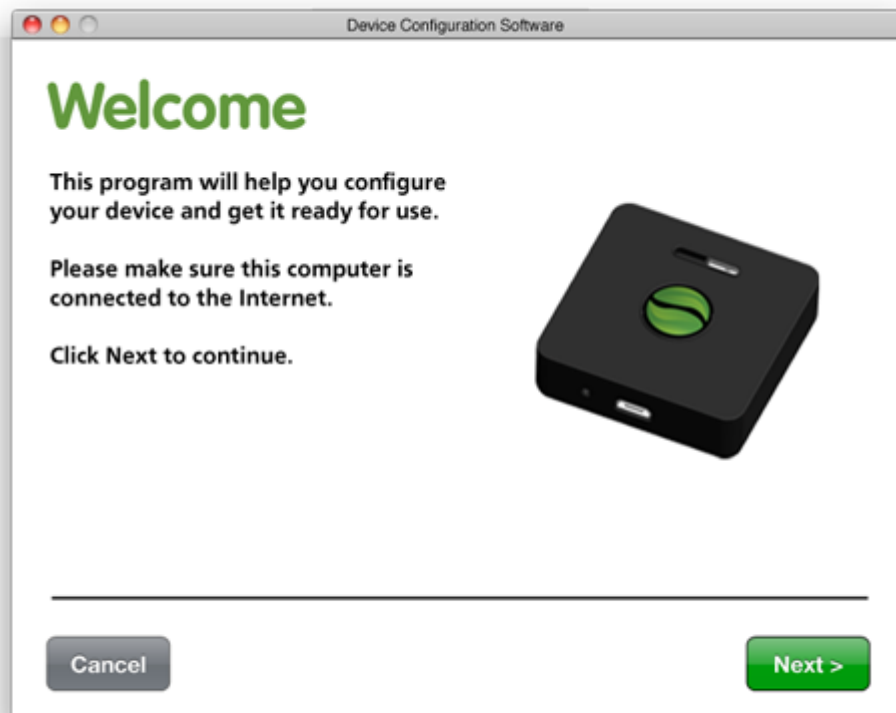
## Configure the Device

Prior to initial use, you must configure the device by specifying a known wireless network and providing your username / password for the LifeShadow account where the audio files will be uploaded.

Insert the included device configuration software CD into your computer and follow the onscreen instructions.




The Welcome screen introduces the device configuration software. Please ensure that the computer you're using to do configuration is connected to the Internet. Click Next to

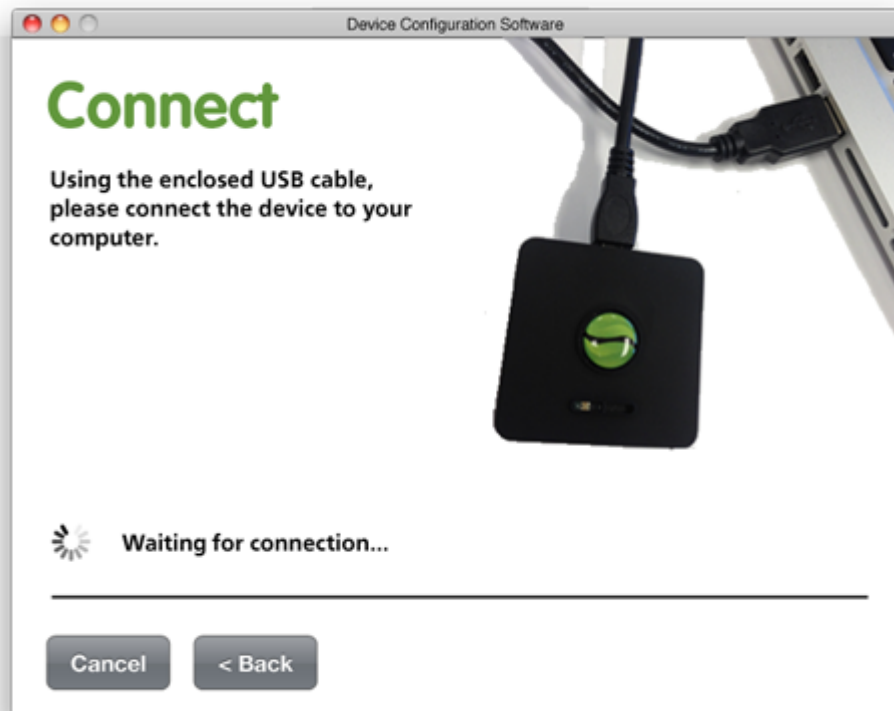

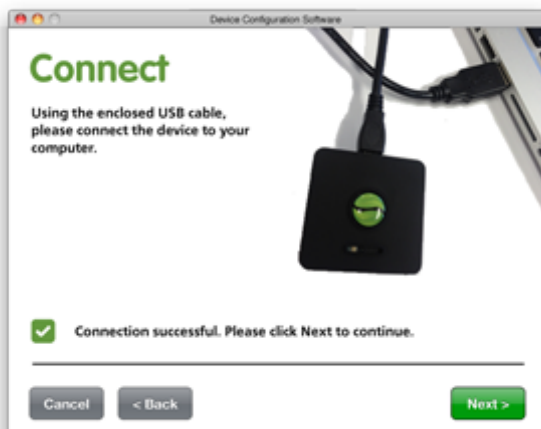

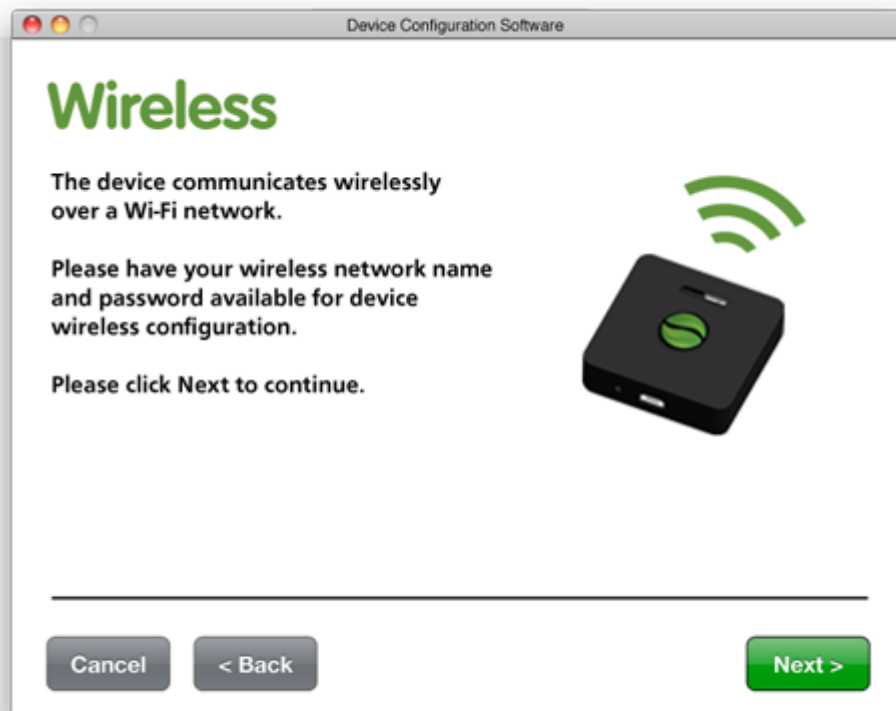
Using the enclosed USB cable, please connect the device to your computer.

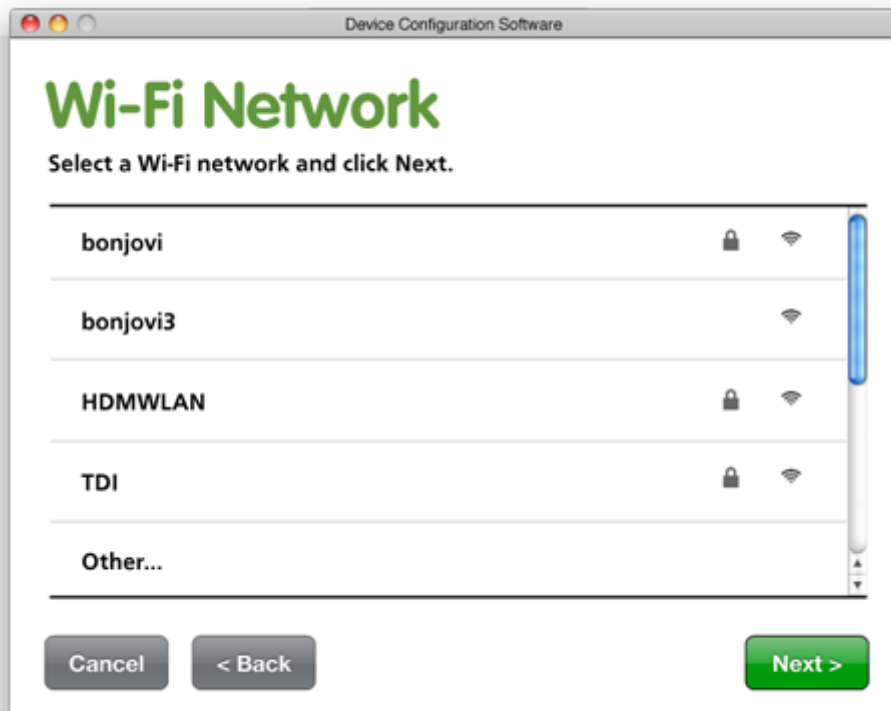
The device requires a connection to a wireless network in order to transmit audio. Please have your wireless network name and password available and click Next to



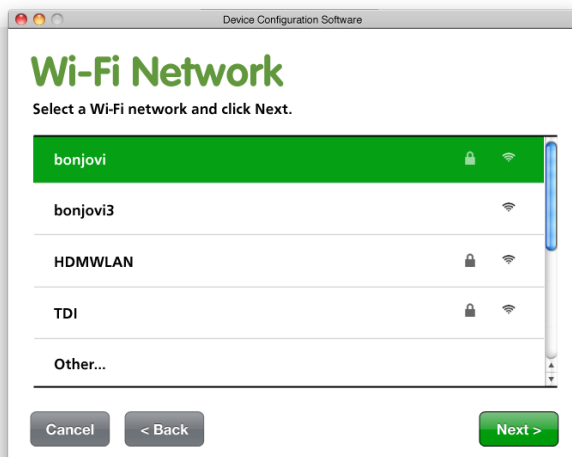


If no networks are listed, your wireless network may not be broadcasting its name. In this case, select 'Other...' and click
