

Car Hauler set – Radio Control Transporter and Vehicle – Owner's Manual

Contains: 2 frequencies (27MHz and 49MHz) in 1 transmitter
Removable charger for vehicle
Transporter include Truck and Trailer – 27MHz
Vehicle – 49MHz

Please read carefully before starting to operate.

SAFETY AND PLAYING TIPS:

Adults: This toy is recommended for children 8 years of age and older. To ensure that the child's play is both safe and fun, please review the operating instructions and these general safety rules with the child. If there are children under the age of eight in the play area, adult supervision is recommended.

- NEVER drive your transporter and vehicle on streets
- DO NOT pick up transporter and vehicle while in motion.
- Keep fingers, hair, and loose clothing away from the tires and the wheel hubs while the vehicle is switched ON.
- Don't play outdoors during thunderstorms.
- Don't drive your transporter and vehicle in sand or through water or snow.
- Don't let your transporter and vehicle go beyond the transmitter frequency range of 25 feet.
- Wipe clean with a dry towel after playing. Do not use chemicals as they can deform or damage the body.
- The radio circuitry in your transporter, vehicle and transmitter is sensitive. Do not store the car hauler, vehicle or transmitter near heat or in direct sunlight.
- Dispose of batteries safely and correctly.
- Do not burn old batteries, batteries may explode or leak.
- WARNING! Do not play with the transmitter close to the ear! Misuse may cause damage to hearing.

PERFORMANCE AND MAINTENANCE TIPS:

- Designed to run on most SMOOTH surfaces.
- When you are through playing with your Car Hauler, turn both the transporter and the transmitter to OFF. Always turn your transporter "OFF" first before turning the transmitter "OFF".
NOTE: Do not leave your transporter "ON" if the transmitter is "OFF"
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- WARNING: Changes or modifications to this unit not expressly approved by the party responsible for compliance could void the user's authority to operate the equipment.

HINT AND TIPS OF HOW TO OPERATE THE TRANSPORTER AND VEHICLE PROPERLY:

- Operating multiple vehicles with the same frequency in close proximity will cause interference and poor performance.
- Works best away from high voltage power lines, large buildings and walls.
- Hold transmitter antenna up for best performance, not pointed down toward vehicle.
- When the vehicle does not respond, slows down, or loses range, replace batteries in transmitter or recharge the Ni-MH battery in vehicle.
- When the transporter does not respond, slows down, or loses range, replace batteries in transporter or in transporter.
- Your vehicle's running time may change depending on your driving style.

HOW TO REPLACE BATTERIES:

- 01>Place all the batteries in the battery box with the correct polarity. Align (-) and (+) accordingly.
- 02>Remove the battery cover on transmitter; insert 2 x AAA alkaline batteries (not included), see diagram 1.
- 03>Release charger from transmitter, see diagram 2
- 04>Remove battery cover from charger; insert 3 x AA alkaline batteries (not included), see diagram 3.
- 04>Remove battery cover from transporter; insert 3 x AAA alkaline batteries (not included), see diagram 4.

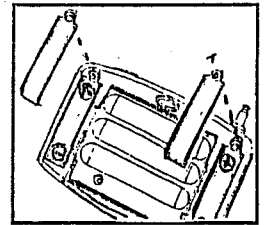

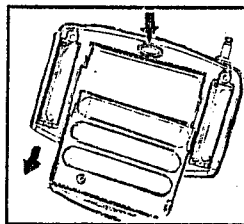

CAUTION WHEN USING BATTERIES:

- Adult supervision is recommended when charging batteries from charger.
- Battery life may vary depending on battery brand.
- Do not attempt to remove Ni-MH battery from vehicle.
- Do not attempt to recharge Ni-MH battery with other charger.
- Do not use rechargeable battery for transmitter.
- Do not attempt to charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard or rechargeable batteries.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not burn old batteries, batteries may explode or leak.
- Dispose of batteries safely and correctly.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- For best performance only use alkaline batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Remove batteries from R/C transmitter if they will not be used for a long period of time.
- Toy performance may decrease as batteries weaken.

HOW TO PLAY THE CAR HAULER:

- 01>Turn the Transmitter to "Transporter"
- 02>Turn the transporter to "ON".
- 03>Make sure trailer hooked on the truck properly, see diagram 5
- 04>Push button located on right top side of transmitter to open and close trailer's door, see diagram 6..
- 05>Switch the direction trimmer if the transporter does not run straight, turn it to left or right until your desired alignment is reached, see diagram 7.

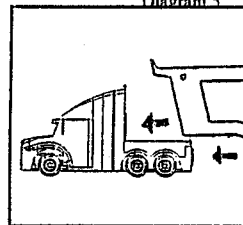

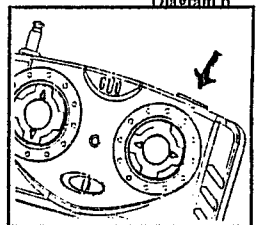

HOW TO PLAY THE VEHICLE:

- 01>Charging your vehicle –
 - a) Must push firmly on vehicle until it locks in to the charger, see diagram 8.
 - b) Vehicle has rechargeable Ni-MH battery. Quick boost charge the vehicle for 120 seconds, aligning polarity accordingly.
 - c) Red LED light on charger indicates that vehicle is charging. When red LED light goes off, charging has been completed.
- 02>Turn the transmitter to "Vehicle"
- 03>Switch the direction trimmer if the vehicle does not run straight, turn it to left or right until your desired alignment is reached, see diagram 7.
