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2.1 INTRODUCTION

The measurement procedure described in American National Standard for Methods of Measurement of Radio-Noise Emissions from Low-Voltage Electrical and Electronic Equipment in the Range of 9kHz to 40GHz (ANSIC63.4-1992) was used in determining radiated and conducted emissions emanating from CAS Corporation. Scales FCC ID: QD8NB-1

The open area test site and conducted measurement facility used to collect the radiated data are located at the 254-1, MAEKOK-RI,HOBUP-MYUN,ICHON-SI,KYOUNGKI-DO, 467-701,KOREA. The site is constructed in conformance with the requirements of ANSI C63.4and CISPR Publication 22. Detailed description of test facility was submitted to the Commission and accepted dated July 24,2000 (Confirmation Number: EA90661)

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3.1 PRODUCT INFORMATION

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4.1 Description of Tests(Conducted)

(Power line Conducted RFI (150kHz- 30MHz))

The power line conducted RFI measurements were performed according to CISPR 22.

The EUT was placed on a non-conducting 1.0 by 1.5 meter table which is 0.8 meters in height and 0.40 meters away from the vertical wall of the shielded enclosure. Power to the EUT is provided through a Rohde & Schwarz 50 Ω / 50 uH Line Impedance Stabilization Network (LISN) and the support equipment through a separate Solar 50 Ω / 50 uH Line- Conducted Test Facility LISN. Sufficient time for the EUT, support equipment, and test equipment were allowed in order for them to warm up to their normal operating condition. The RF output of the LISN was connected to the spectrum analyzer to determine the frequency producing the maximum EME. The spectrum was scanned from 150kHz to 30 MHz. Each maximum EME was measured using an EMI receiver. The detector function of the receiver was set to CISPR quasi- peak and average mode with the bandwidth set to 9 kHz. Each emission was maximized consistent with the typical applications by varying the configuration of the test sample. Interface cables were connected to the available interface ports of the test unit. The effect of varying the position of cables was investigated to find the configuration that produces maximum Diagram emission. Excess cable lengths were bundled at the center with 30- 40cm. in length. The worst-case configuration is noted in the test report and the photographs are attached. Each EME reported was calibrated using the Rohde & Schwarz SMX signal generator and are listed on Table 1. RFI Conducted FCC Class B

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4.2 Description of Tests(Radiated)

(Radiated Emissions)

Preliminary measurements were made indoors at 1 meter using broadband antennas, broadband amplifier, and spectrum analyzer to determine the frequency producing the maximum EME. Appropriate precaution was taken to ensure that all EME from the EUT were maximized and investigated. The spectrum was scanned from 30 to 300 MHz using biconical antenna, 300 to 1000 MHz using log-periodic antenna, and above 1 GHz using linearly polarized horn antennas. Final measurements were made outdoors at 10meter test range using Dipole antennas and EMI receiver. For frequencies above 1 GHz, horn antennas were used. Sufficient time for the EUT, support equipment, and test equipment were allowed in order for them to warm up to their normal operating condition. The EMI receiver detector function was set to CISPR quasi-peak mode and the bandwidth of the receiver was set to 120 kHz. The EUT, support equipment, and interconnecting cables were arranged to the configuration that produces the maximum EME emission found during preliminary scan. The turntable containing the system was rotated; the antenna height was varied 1 to 4 meters and stopped at the azimuth or height producing the maximum emission. Horizontal and vertical antenna polarizations were checked. Each emission was maximized by: varying the mode of operation or resolution; clock or data exchange speed; scrolling H pattern to the EUT and/ or support equipment, and powering the monitor the computer aux AC outlet, if applicable; and changing the polarity of the antenna, whichever determined the worst-case emission.




