This letter confirms that the device with FCC ID: QDS-BRCM1020 operates on Ch 1-11 in the US. Operation is and will be limited to band 2412 - 2462 MHz. Ch 12 and 13 are not used on this card in the US.

This application reduces the frequency range of operation previously granted of 2412 - 2472 MHz (channels 1 through 13) by dropping channels 12 and 13, giving an operating frequency range of 2412 - 2462 MHz. The product has never been shipped with the capability to operate on channels 12 and 13 in the US, therefore there is no risk of the proposed device being operated on channels 12 and 13 through the use of an older version of software driver in the US.
