We have done a SAR evaluation for this new portable host and are submitting for a Class II Permissive Change filing. There is no change on the module hardware and the antennas used in this portable host is the same antenna type as the previous with less gain by comparing to the certified antennas included in the original modular approval, and output power remains unchanged. Therefore EMC tests are not performed.
