Bluetooth earphone



Charging the earphone:

Please make sure the earphone is full of charge before using it for the first time.

- 1. Connect the included Micro USB Charging cable to the USB Charging Port of the earphone.
- 2. The red indicator will turn on when charging, it will die out after full charged

Bluetooth function:

- 1. Press the button POWER/TEL/PP 3seconds, the Blue indicator flash, then blue and red indicator flash alternately, and it is pairing mode.
- 2. Turn on the Bluetooth of your Smartphone. Search for Bluetooth device and select "LC-D02"
- 3. Enter the code "0000" if needed
- Blue indicator will light on and it is ready for use. VOL+ /Next Song: Long press the button + VOL-/ Pre song: Short press the button -Play/Pause: short press POWER/TEL/PP Power OFF: press the button POWER/TEL/PP 3seconds.

If there is no operation within 5 minutes after Power ON, it will power OFF automatically.

- 5. Answer/End a call: Short Press the button POWER/TEL/PP
- 6. Reject a Call: Double press the button POWER/TEL/PP
- 7. Redial the last called number: Double press the button POWER/TEL/PP

Remark: 1. the earphone will connect to your Smartphone automatically the next time when you turn it on.
