Bluetooth setup:

- 1. Connect the provided charging cable to a power source and to the micro USB port on the speaker.
- 2. Turn ON/OFF switch to the ON position. Speaker will tone and LED indicator begin to flash BLUE and in pairing mode.
- 3. Turn on the Bluetooth function on mobile device, select "Coast Speaker" pairing name. LED will slowly flash BLUE if successfully paired.
- 4. Speaker will automatically pair if the mobile device has been paired before.

Wireless charging

- 1. Place wireless charging supported mobile device on top charging pad
- 2. Phone will begin to charge automatically
