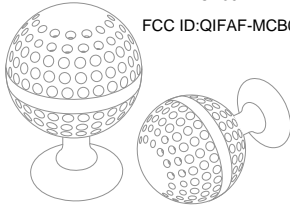

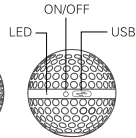

● BLUETOOTH INSTRUCTION (NOTE: THE DEVICE IS GOIF, PAIR CODE: 0000)

1. Long press the "Power on/off" button 3 seconds, hear the prompt sound and the blue indicator flash quickly and it means that it has entered Bluetooth pairing status.
2. Starting up the Bluetooth device (Golf), select it and it will be prompted for a password (Note: some mobile phone can be connected directly without entering pairing code), enter "0000" number, press "Yes" to connect the Bluetooth device (Golf).
3. The Golf speaker is ready for use.
4. Bluetooth re-connection
 - a. When the phone and Bluetooth communication beyond the effective range ($\geq 10M$), it will be

disconnected. After the phone back to the effective range ($\leq 10M$), you have to reconnect phone and Bluetooth to make it work again.

- b. When Bluetooth power is cut off, re-switch to the Bluetooth status, select Bluetooth to connect.

● CHARGING THE BATTERY

1. When battery is low, the Bluetooth speaker will make a beep every 30seconds during playing music, please recharge it in time to continuous use.
2. Plug the provided USB charging cable into the speaker and an active computer USB port or a USB AC adapter that is plugged into an active wall outlet.
3. Charging time: 2-2.5hours
