## User's Manual Commander Bluetooth Speaker

- 1) Commander Bluetooth Speaker

- 3) Micro-USB - USB / 3.5mm Audio Cable

### TECHNICAL DETAILS

- 1) Input: DC5V
- 2) Output: 2W (1KHz, THD10%)
- 3) Frequency: 200Hz—20KHz
- 4) Impedance: 4Ω
- 5) Speaker Driver Size: 36mm
- 6) Product Dimensions: Dia-5cm x H-5.5cm

### BLUETOOTH OPERATION:

Press and hold the POWER ON/OFF button until a tone sounds and the blue LED indicator begins flashing - indicating the speaker is in pairing mode. In the Bluetooth available devices menu on audio device, locate "Commander" and follow your device's instructions to connect and play audio through the Commander Speaker.

### LINE-IN MODE:

Insert the Micro-USB end of the cable into the speaker. Located on the opposite end is a USB and 3.5mm Audio plug. Insert the 3.5mm Audio plug into your device's headphone port. Double press the POWER ON/OFF button to switch to Line-in mode.

*\*Audio must be controlled using the audio device's controls in this mode.*

### BUTTON FUNCTIONS:

- 1) key
  - a - Press and hold until a tone sounds indicating the speaker is turning ON/OFF.
  - b - Double press to switch to Line-in Mode.
  - c - When call is incoming, press once to answer. Press twice to ignore.
- 2) key
  - a - Press and hold to decrease the volume.
  - b - Press once to skip to the previous track.
- 3) key
  - a - Press and hold to increase the volume.
  - b - Press once to skip to the next track.

### LED INDICATOR:

- 1) Rapid Flashing / Blue ----- Power ON/Pairing mode
- 2) Solid / Blue ----- Bluetooth connected
- 3) Slow Flash / Blue ----- Line-In Mode Active
- 4) Solid / Red ----- Charging

### WARNING:

- To avoid damage or injury, operate only as indicated in this manual.

- Do not obstruct the speaker by inserting foreign objects or covering.
- Keep out of reach of children.
