

4. You can connect a 3.5mm jack headset to the Bluetooth Adapter and use it to hear music.

5 Button function:

" MIN " : In the standby mode, press the " MIN " button once to play music, again to pause.

Previous, Volume - / Next, Volume + :

When the adapter is playing music, Long press " ^ " to decrease volume, short press to enter previous song. Long press " ~ " to increase volume, short press to enter next song.

- 6. When there is a calling, press the " IN " button of the adapter once to receive it.
- 7. After the calling is over, press the " >> " button once to end it.
- 8. When there is a call, long press the multi-function button for 2S to refuse it.
- 9. Press the multi-function button until the red light flickers, and then the device is powered off.

## Recharging battery

Plug micro USB cable into the 5V socket, connect to USB port of Computer for charging battery, the red indicator light on and the light will be out after full charged.

Remark: Before the first use, the battery must be fully charged
